Surviving are his wife of Gorham; a son, David H. of Standish; a daughter, Cynthia Hoyt of Cornish; and five grandchildren.







Brooks, 65, widely known orchardist, for a long time a commission fruit dealer and in recent years an automobile salesman and real estate dealer, died suddenly at his home here this morning. He had been in ill health for several months, but was able to attend to his business Monday. He was born at Oak Hill, in this town, the son of Royal and Alvira Manson Brooks, and received his education in the town chools and at Limington Academy.

FLISWORTH and CRANBERRY ISLES Carl Ara Brooks, 80, died Dec. 15. 1989 at Ellsworth. He was born in South Portland, Feb. 4, 1908, the son of Ara Curtis Brooks and Bertha (Haycock) Brooks. He attended schools in Orrington and Columbia Falls. In 1931, he graduated from the University of Maine with a degree of Bachelor of Science (Civil Engineering) with distinction. He was elected to both Phi Beta Kappa and Tau Beta Pi honor societies. He was a registered structural engineer. He worked for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on the original Passamaguoddy Power Project. He joined the bridge division of the State of Maine Highway Department where he designed bridges and inspected their construction throughout the state. He had project responsibility for various bridges in the state including the current International Bridge between Calais and St. Stephen, New Brunswick, Canada, Subsequently advancing to utility engineer for the department, he was responsible for the electric, telephone, water and other utility aspects of all highway projects within the State of Maine. He was a popular lun-

cheon speaker among utility organizations with a style that mixed a Downeast humor with the facts of the business. He represented all of the New England states on utility matters of the National Right-of-Way Association and the U.S. Federal Highway Administration. He received an award for 25 years of meritorious service from the American Association of State Highway Officials. He built his retirement home in Ellsworth in 1969. However, his state office was moved to the Maine Department of Transportation Ellsworth facility. He finally retired in 1972. Never one to retire, he undertook consulting projects for towns including Cranberry Isles and Ellsworth. He was selectman for the town of Cranberry Isles. Failing health forced him to leave Great Cranberry Island in 1985. Nevertheless, he continued to prepare the annual Town Report and perform other administrative duties for the town until 1989. He enjoyed walking the carridge roads and climbing the mountains of Acadia National Park with his grandsons. He was a 50-year Mason 

and a member of the Maine Society or Professional Engineers. He was predeceased by one son, Edward "Ebbie" Spurling Brooks in 1952. He is survived by his wife of 58 years. Barbara Spurling Brooks of Ellsworth; one son, Carl N. Brooks; and two grandsons. Carl N. Brooks II and Francis C. Brooks of Chagrin Falls, Ohio, and Cranberry Isles. There will be service of remembrance at 11 a.m. Tuesday at the Fernald Funeral Chapel, Mount Desert, with the Rev. Tony Burkhart officiating.
