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## WPA Foreman Found Lying By Exhaust Pipe Of Auto, Killed By Monoxide

SANFORD, Jan. 21 (Special.)—  
Dr. Stephen A. Cobb, medical examiner, completing investigation of the death of Freeman M. Brierly, 55, this noon announced the death suicide by carbon monoxide poisoning.

Brierly was found dead in the garage in the rear of his School Street home Wednesday night, after being missing since 8.30 a. m., when he left a sewer job on which he had been a WPA boss. Dead several hours, he was lying with his face near the exhaust pipe of his automobile.

He was a native of Milton Mills, N. H., and had resided in Sanford since a boy. He conducted a plumbing establishment here for many years and also served as sewer inspector for the town for several years. He was a member of Preble Lodge of Masons and Sanford Lodge of Elks.

Besides his wife, he leaves two brothers, John W. and William H., both of Sanford.

Dr. Henry H. Brock, 89, prominent Maine surgeon, died yesterday at his home at Lyman.

Most of his practice was done in Portland, but Doctor Brock lived in semi-retirement the past few years at his farm home on the shores of Bunganut Pond, Lyman. He performed a major operation on his 80th birthday.

Doctor Brock was born in Portland May 30, 1864. His parents were George and Alice Lowe Brock. Doctor Brock's mother was descended from Capt. John Lowe of Revolutionary fame. He received his early education in

Portland public schools and was graduated from Amherst College in 1886. In 1890, he was graduated at the head of his class from the Department of Bowdoin.

He then became an interne in the Maine General Hospital for one year before accepting an appointment as Portland city physician. Afterwards, he entered upon an 18-year associateship with Dr. Stephen Holmes Weeks, one of Maine's leading surgeons.

Dr. Brock was elected an adjunct surgeon to the Maine General Hospital and made instructor in surgery at Bowdoin. From 1897 to 1917, he was surgeon to the Maine General. He became assistant professor of surgery at Bowdoin in 1900 and, in 1905, its Clinical Professor of Surgery.

Until recently, Dr. Brock was

consulting surgeon to the Maine General Hospital, the Webber Hospital at Biddeford and the Goodall Hospital at Sanford. His medical societies included the Lister Club, the Innominate Club, the Portland Medical Club, the Cumberland County Medical Society, the Maine Medical Association, the American Medical Association and the American College of Surgeons.

Dr. Brock was one of the original trustees of the Portland Farmers Club, completed 50 years in Masonry as a member of Ancient Landmark Lodge and was an authority on North American ornithology. He often lectured before the Portland Natural History Society.

Dr. Brock married Mary Elizabeth Rounds, who died in 1936.

He is survived by one son, Henry W. Brock of Lyman, four grandchildren and three great-

grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. tomorrow at 3 William St. The Rev. James W. Lenhart, pastor of the State Street Congregational Church, will officiate. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery.

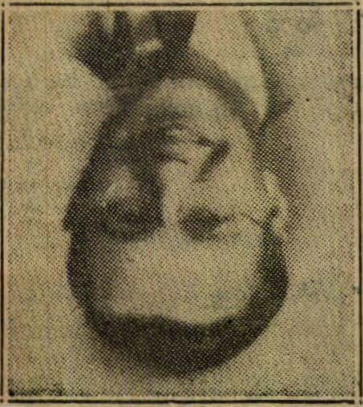

ELLSWORTH AND CRANBERRY ISLES  
Carl Ara Brooks, 80, died Dec. 15, 1989, at Ellsworth. He was born in South Portland, Feb. 4, 1908, the son of Ara Curtis Brooks and Bertha (Haycock) Brooks. He attended schools in Orrington and Columbia Falls. In 1931, he graduated from the University of Maine with a degree of Bachelor of Science (Civil Engineering) with distinction. He was elected to both Phi Beta Kappa and Tau Beta Pi honor societies. He was a registered structural engineer. He worked for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on the original Passamaquoddy Power Project. He joined the bridge division of the State of Maine Highway Department where he designed bridges and inspected their construction throughout the state. He had project responsibility for various bridges in the state including the current International Bridge between Calais and St. Stephen, New Brunswick, Canada. Subsequently advancing to utility engineer for the department, he was responsible for the electric, telephone, water and other utility aspects of all highway projects within the State of Maine. He was a popular lun-

cheon speaker among utility organizations with a style that mixed a Downeast humor with the facts of the business. He represented all of the New England states on utility matters at the National Right-of-Way Association and the U.S. Federal Highway Administration. He received an award for 25 years of meritorious service from the American Association of State Highway Officials. He built his retirement home in Ellsworth in 1969. However, his state office was moved to the Maine Department of Transportation Ellsworth facility. He finally retired in 1972. Never one to retire, he undertook consulting projects for towns including Cranberry Isles and Ellsworth. He was selectman for the town of Cranberry Isles. Failing health forced him to leave Great Cranberry Island in 1985. Nevertheless, he continued to prepare the annual Town Report and perform other administrative duties for the town until 1989. He enjoyed walking the carriage roads and climbing the mountains of Acadia National Park with his grandsons. He was a 50-year Mason

and a member of the Maine Society of Professional Engineers. He was predeceased by one son, Edward "Ebbie" Spurling Brooks in 1952. He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Barbara Spurling Brooks of Ellsworth; one son, Carl N. Brooks; and two grandsons, Carl N. Brooks II and Francis C. Brooks of Chagrin Falls, Ohio, and Cranberry Isles. There will be service of remembrance at 11 a.m. Tuesday at the Fernald Funeral Chapel, Mount Desert, with the Rev. Tony Burkhart officiating. Those friends who wish, please do a kindness for someone in Carl's memory.
