
Daniel M. Brown, 85, of 23 Pembroke St., died unexpectedly yesterday at a local hospital following a brief illness.

Born in Bridgton, March 23, 1901, he was a son of Walter H. and Florence Kennison Brown.


Educated in Bridgton schools, he had been a machinist and welder for 25 years. Prior to this he worked for the Bridgton and Harrison Railroads for 25 years.
