Paul B. "Rocky" Bridges Jr., 77, of Allen Avenue, a man who knew more about baseball than most, died Saturday at a Yarmouth health care facility.

Mr. Bridges was well known in baseball circles, often telling people that he was raised with a baseball in his crib. His father, Paul "Slick" Bridges Sr., was a pitcher and outfielder who played for Oklahoma City in the Detroit Tigers organization before an injury cut short his career.

Influenced by his father, Mr. Bridges played school baseball, including infield positions at Dalton High School and with the Crown Cotton Mills semipro team in Georgia.

Mr. Bridges joined the Navy in 1941 and served for many years. After retiring from the military, he was employed for 15 years by the U.S. Postal Service in the Greater Portland area.

In 1963, he found his way back into baseball, this time as an umpire in local games in Maine. Mr. Bridges took his umpire training so seriously that he began learning positioning at Deering Oaks during the middle of winter, his friend Sonny Noel recalled in a 1982 Portland Evening Express story.

"I told myself 'Any guy who can't wait for the snow to melt must be serious,'" Mr. Noel said.

Mr. Bridges thrived as an umpire, working six and seven games a week locally and gaining a reputation as a stickler for the rules. From 1965 until 1985, he was active in umpiring high school baseball and American Legion baseball games. He was athletic director for the Caldwell Post and served as the zone commissioner for American Legion Baseball. He ran the Babe Ruth state and regional tournaments and was a life member of the Western Maine Board of Umpires.

PASSAGES

Mr. Bridges retired from umpiring in 1985 when he decided that his reflexes were slowing and he worried that he would begin making bad calls.

"If I'm going to go out, I want to go out like Ted Williams," Mr. Bridges told the Evening Express. "Williams hit a home run his final time up. And when he dropped his bat, he said c'est la vie."

Mr. Bridges was born in Birmingham, Ala., a son of Paul B. and Ruby Hunt Bridges. He graduated from Dalton High School in Tunnel Hill, Ga., in 1936 and attended Georgia Tech University on a football scholarship.

In later life, Mr. Bridges also was active in tenpin bowling. He served as secretary and treasurer of the Maine and New England Tenpin Bowling Association, and was elected to the Maine Tenpin Bowling Hall of Fame. He was a fan of the Maine Mariners and Portland Pirates hockey teams, and also a Boston Celtics basketball fan.

Mr. Bridges was active in the Masons for 43 years, as a member of the Henry Knox Lodge in Boston and the Cornerstone Lodge in Portland. He was a member of the Ralph T. Caldwell Post and the Stephen W. Manchester Post of the American Legion of Portland and Westbrook.

His wife, Arlene Bridges, died in January 1992. Surviving are a son, Paul B. of Portland, and a daughter, Penny Bridges of Portland.

A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. Tuesday at the Chestnut Street United Methodist Church in Portland, with the Rev. Edward Fenderson officiating.

Ralph E. Bridges

Ralph E. Bridges, 65, former manager of Porteous Mitchell & Braun Company's Furniture Department, died Sunday afternoon in the Maine General Hospital after suffering a heart attack Sunday morning in his home, 97 Woodford Street.

Mr. Bridges was born at Bangor May 29, 1879, son of Robert and Mary Mayberry Bridges. He was graduated from Bangor High School and was employed in banks at Bangor and Presque Isle, and later was in the bond business. Enlisting Nov. 16, 1917, he served in the infantry with the 106th Division, AEF in France, receiving injuries which necessitated nine months of hospitalization.

After the war, Mr. Bridges was employed by the Atherton Furniture Company for about 10 years, first at their Lewiston store and then in the Portland store. Entering business for himself under the firm name of Bridges & Bell, he conducted a furniture store at Morrill's Corner here four years. Upon the opening of a Furniture Department at Porteous, Mitchell & Braun's he became manager and continued in that capacity until ill health forced him to become a buyer, being employed there about 10 years.

Mr. Bridges was a 32nd degree Mason and a member of Ralph D. Caldwell Post, American Legion, and the Elks.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Julia M. Bridges; a sister, Mrs. Mabel Jones of Lewiston; and a nephew, Robert Jones.
