BINGHAM, May 15 (Special)—Dr. Ray C. Brown, 62, Somerset County physician and county medical examiner, died of a heart attack in his office here Friday.

A native of Clinton, he was educated in the Clinton schools, Coburn Classical Institute at Waterville and Jefferson Medical College, Philadelphia. He first practiced in Bingham for about 20 years and then for short times was in Pittsfield, Waterville and Richmond. He was at Skowhegan during construction of Wyman Dam and two years ago went to Harrington. When the two local physicians went into the service, he resumed practice here on petition of Bingham residents but retained his residence at Skowhegan.
