LINWOOD CLINTON BROWN

No. 5542 Noble Linwood "Lindy" Clinton Brown of Punta Gorda FL was born March 23, 1922, in Vanceboro and died peacefully January 5, 2006, in Punta Gorda.

He graduated from Vanceboro High School in 1939 and served in the 82nd Bomb Squadron of the 10th Air Force during World War II, attaining the rank of Staff Sergeant, serving as a gunnery instructor and tail gunner aboard, Leggy Lady, a B-25 bomber. He flew 49 missions, 207 combat hours, in the CBI Theater in Burma, China and Thailand in 1944-45, for which he received the Distinguished Flying Cross. After the war, he returned to Vanceboro, where

he married Diane (Main) Brown. He began his life-long work for the railroad, first as a fireman and then as an engineer for Canadian Pacific and Maine Central Railroad. He and Diane and their four children moved to Calais in 1962. He was a past commander of the American Legion, Post No. 3. He was a catcher and first baseman while playing semi-pro baseball in Canada throughout the 40s and 50s and for the Calais Mets in the late 50s and early 60s. He umpired Calais Little League baseball in the 60s and 70s. He retired in 1982, after 43 years on the railroad.

In 1990, he and Diane moved to Punta Gorda, Fla.

His Masonic affiliations included membership in St. Croix Lodge No. 46 of Calais and other Masonic Bodies. His enrollment in Anah Shriners was recorded as May 18, 1963.
