### **biology teacher, pianist in area bands**

STAATSBURG, N.Y. — Norman T. Bruce, 82, who had lived here since December after coming from Windham, Maine, died Tuesday at Northern Dutchess Hospital, Rhinebeck.

Mr. Bruce was a biology teacher at Cape Elizabeth (Maine) High School, until his retirement in 1972, and was a driving instructor there. 8-18-1992

He was born in South Lawrence, Mass., son of William and Margaret Mill Bruce.

An accomplished pianist, he worked all over Maine with some of its finest musicians, including the big bands of Al Corey in the Waterville area and Don Doane's band around Portland. He played for years with the Bob Percival at Island Park, a night spot outside Augusta.

"I don't think there is a place I haven't played around here," he told a Press Herald interviewer in 1981. He was a member of the Presumpscot Masonic Lodge, Windham, and the United Church of Christ, Windham.

On April 16, 1938, he married Evelyn Crawford in Lawrence.

Surviving, besides his wife, are two sons, Duncan of Staatsburg and Graham of Richmond, Calif.; a sister, Beverly Silva of Escondido, Calif.; and two step-grandchildren.

assessors is basically a long-term planned approach" to improve property tax assessments.

### PLAN NOT NEW

Dr. Frank stressed that the recommendation is not new and that state law now specifies that the state tax assessor may establish property assessment districts and supervisors to work with local tax assessors.

He said, however, Dr. Sly's report points out that "without larger assessment districts" than now theoretically called for by state law, and without "some full-time personnel, progress in improving assessment of property taxes will be slow."

"Dr. Sly recommends that these districts be set up imme-

diately. He said districts to not more than six and provides that no county may be divided between two districts.

He said districts should "contain sufficient property so that property taxes will be great enough to make it worthwhile to hire a professional assessor."

Before the districts become a reality, Dr. Frank said, problems such as the relationship of supervisory personnel and local assessors must be carefully delineated.

"It is much better to go slowly and explore all implications of a proposed change than it is to accept a series of good recommendations and plunge into a program," Dr. Frank said.

Funeral services for Capt. James G. Bryant, 79, of 26 Ocean View Avenue, South Portland, retired master mariner and pilot, who died Thursday morning in the State Street Hospital, will be held at 2.30 today in the funeral home of George J.
