Loring Bryant, 80, retired Grand Trunk Railway engineer, died suddenly of a heart ailment Sunday afternoon in the home of his daughter, Mrs. Adella B. Allen, 23 Victory Avenue, South Portland.

Mr. Bryant, the son of William G. and Phoebe Billings Bryant, was born at Woodstock, Feb. 27, 1862. He entered the employ of the Grand Trunk Railway as a coal boy. His life was devoted to railroading with the Grand Trunk until his retirement 15 years ago.

He married Emma Wilson of Gorham, N. H., in 1886. Mr. and Mrs. Bryant came to Portland in 1900, residing in East Deering until Mrs. Bry-

ant's death in 1939. Since then Mr. Bryant had made his home with his daughter at South Portland.

He was a member of Deering Lodge and Mount Vernon Chapter of Masons and the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers. His daughter was his only near relative.

BETHEL — Richard N. Bryant, 66, of Vernon Street, an active member of the Bethel community, died Saturday at a Lewiston hospital after a brief illness.

A lifelong resident, he was a son of Myron and Doris Goodnow Bryant, and graduated from Gould Academy in 1946 after serving two years in the Navy during World War II.

On Oct. 10, 1948, he married Barbara Wilson in Bethel.

Mr. Bryant was the fourth generation to own and operate Bryant's Food Store, Bethel, and opened the IGA Store on Main Street in 1964. After selling the business in the late 1960s, he worked at Jack Frost Ski Shops in Maine and New Hampshire during the winter, where he was currently employed, and spent 17 summers working in Ogunquit.

He was a member of the West Parish Congregational Church, the Bethel Masonic Lodge, past worthy patron of the Purity Chapter, OES, Kora Temple Shrine and the Mundt Allen Post American Legion, Bethel.

He was a former incorporator of the Bethel Savings Bank, a life member of the Bethel Historical Society, and past member of the Bethel Chamber of Commerce and the Bethel Players.

A son, Gregory, died in 1981.

Surviving are his wife of Bethel; a daughter, Susan B. Leighton of South Portland; a sister, Carolyn Bryant Forks of Belfast; and four grandchildren.

Carl Edward Buck Buchanan, 77

OLD TOWN-- Carl Edward Buck Buchanan, 77, died unexpectedly Dec. 9, 2006, while visiting friends in Millinocket. He was born June 17, 1929, in Milford, the youngest of seven children of William and Jennie (Spinney) Buchanan.

After graduating from Stearns High School in 1946, Buck enlisted in the Navy and served on the USS Winslow, the USS Fresno and the USS Proteus, a submarine tender at New London, Conn. It was there that he met his future wife Sonia, who was working at the time in an ice cream shop. They were married Jan. 7, 1955, in Hartford, Conn.

In Oct. 1954, Buck joined the Maine State Police, and upon graduating from the Maine State Police Academy he was assigned to Troop C in Skowhegan and patrolled from Skowhegan to Jackman. In 1956, Buck was promoted to Detective and was transferred to Troop E in Orono. He remained a Detective until his retirement in 1975.

Buck took great pride in his work as an investigator and was known by many as a legendary State Police Detective. He was also known by some as a rebel due to his outspoken nature and his decision to sometimes do it his own way, albeit with the intended results.

During the course of his career he received training that included, but was not limited to: Homicide Investigation at the Harvard Associates in Police Science at Harvard University; Narcotics Investigation at what was then known as the United States Narcotics Bureau in Washington, DC; Questioned Documents Examination at the U.S. Dept. of Treasury; and Organized Crime Investigation Training in Rhode Island. He was the Senior Intelligence Officer with the New England Organized Crime Intelligence System (NEOCIS) headquartered in Wellesley, Mass. from 1971 to 1973. He retired from the State Police at the rank of Detective Sergeant.

Carl Edward Buck Buchanan

Upon his retirement, he began his career in the private sector as a private investigator. His new business, Carl E. Buchanan & Associates, quickly became known throughout the state and beyond as a premier investigative service, obviously as a result of having brought his many years of experience as an investigator to the business. He retired from the business in May 2005.

Upon his retirement, Buck spent time at home with his wife and so enjoyed visiting. His home was always open to those who wanted to visit. He
