## Hosea B. Buck



Bangor, Feb. 23—Funeral services for Hosea B. Buck, 65, prominent timberland manager, and University of Maine alumnus, who died at his home, 235 French Street, Monday night, will be conducted Thursday afternoon.

Mr. Buck was born at Stillwater, and attended the Old Town public schools and the University of Maine, being graduated from the latter institution in civil engineering in the class of 1893. While at Maine he was a member of the Phi Gamma Delta fraternity and taught school at Ashland, in vacations.

Upon completion of his college course, he entered the local office of Coe and Pingree, timberland owners, advancing to the position of manager of that great estate in Maine.

He served on the board of trustees of the university and was, at the time of his death, chairman of the board. He was an honorary member of Scabbard and Blade, a student military organization, and had been awarded the Pine Tree service emblem, given annually to an alumnus for distinguished service. Mr. Buck was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of the Mystic Shrine, and past noble grand of Oriental Lodge

Bucknam, a former president of the Maine Pharmaceutical Association, was reported by relatives to have been despondent over poor health.



Joseph Sumner Bucknam, 75, retired businessman and twice a member of the Maine House of Representatives, died Monday evening at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Thomas A. Foster, 30 Bramhall Street.

Born at Eastport, he attended school there and later Gray's Business College in Portland. When a young man he established with W. H. Colwell the firm of Bucknam and Colwell, in which he maintained an active interest 25 years.
