SOUTH BERWICK, Feb. 12.—Funeral services for John M. Burleigh, one of the most prominent citizens of the town, succeeding his father, the late Congressman John H. Burleigh of this town, in the management of the Burleigh Blanket Mills, will be held Sunday afternoon at 3 from his home. Mr. Burleigh died Friday, following an illness of but a few days.

Mr. Burleigh was born in Somersworth, N. H., 72 years ago, and when a young boy came here with his parents and had since made his home here. He received his preparatory education in the public schools and in Berwick Academy in this town, and Phillips Exeter Academy, where he fitted for college, graduating from Williams College in 1878. After graduating from Harvard Law School he practiced law for some time in Lafayette, Ind., for two years, and in Montana for five years, coming to South Berwick at the end of that time. Succeeding to executive positions in the mill, he continued in active direction of affairs until a year ago, when he retired.

He was prominent in the Masons, and was a member of the Grand Lodge for many years. He was engaged in writing a history of St. John's Lodge of this town, which was to have been his contribution at the centennial celebration to be held this year.

He is survived by his wife, two daughters, Mrs. Tracy A. Adams of North Adams, Mass., and Mrs. James W. Bixler of Exeter, N. H., and a son, John H. Burleigh of Burlington, Vt.

Augusta, Aug. 11.—Lewis A. Burleigh, jr., 52, insurance supervisor for New England Public Service, Inc., died today in the Augusta General Hospital from knife wounds.

Dr. Wilson H. McWethy, Kennebec County medical examiner, gave a verdict of suicide.

Socially Prominent

His wife, Mrs. Ursula Maher Burleigh, was in the same hospital in "pretty good" condition, with cuts on the head, arms and shoulders, suffered, according to a family spokesman, when she sought to prevent her husband from slashing his throat.

Burleigh, socially prominent, had been in ill health and had returned to his Western Avenue home from a Boston hospital Tuesday night. Members of the family said he had been depressed because of his physical condition.

He was grandson of the late Edwin C. Burleigh, governor of Maine from 1889 to 1893, and later U. S. senator from Maine. His grandfather also was owner for many years of the Kennebec Journal here.

Patrolman Henry Douin said John F. Plummer, Augusta funeral director, was summoned to the Burleigh home about 6.30 p. m. by Mrs. Burleigh. Plummer said he found Mrs. Burleigh "covered with blood." She asked to be taken to the hospital and for someone to look after her husband.

Used Paring Knife

Two of Plummer's helpers took her to the hospital and Plummer said he entered the house in time to see Burleigh try to slash himself, then run from the kitchen with a paring knife, slash at his throat in the garage and then faint.

When he was taken to the hospital, physicians felt both had a chance of recovery. Burleigh had two neck wounds.

Burleigh, born in Augusta, July 20, 1897, was the son of Lewis A. and Caddie Brown Burleigh. He was graduated from Cony High School here Bowdoin College in 1919, and Harvard Law School in 1922. He was admitted to the Kennebec Bar in 1922.

He practiced law here for several years and was in partnership with Robert B. Williamson, now a Maine Supreme Court justice. Later he joined the legal department of the Central Maine Power Company.

He had served as a U. S. commissioner and as a House clerk for the 82nd Legis-

Member In World War

He was an ensign in naval aviation in World War I, and was a member of Fitzgerald-Cummings American Legion, here. He was a past master of Augusta A. F. & A. M., for many years a director of the Augusta General Hospital, had served for a number of years as treasurer of the Augusta Country Club, and was a member of the South Paris Congregational Church.

First Lieutenant Edwin Capen Burnard, 41, AUS, former Portland newspaperman and secretary of the Maine Golf Association, died suddenly Wednesday aboard his ship, docked at the San Francisco Port of Embarkation, the War Department notified, his

widow, Mrs. M. Helen Burnard, 225 Prospect Street, Thursday.

Lieutenant Burnard had just returned after one of several trips he had made to the South and Southwest Pacific on Army troop and supply ships since his assignment to Fort Mason, Calif., nearly two years ago with the Transportation Corps of the Army Transport Service. He enlisted in the Army in November, 1942, was graduated from the Army Administrative Officer Candidate School at Mississippi State College, and commissioned a second lieutenant in May, 1943. He was promoted to first lieutenant a year later. Lieutenant Burnard was home on leave in December.

He was born July 9, 1903, at Corinna, son of Mrs. Josie Burnard of Prospect Street and the

late Joseph Burnard of Dexter. He was graduated from the N. H. Fay High School, Dexter, in 1921, where he was captain of the basketball team, and from Bowdoin College in 1925, where he was on the football squad, manager of the baseball team and president of Chi Psi Fraternity. He entered the employ of the Press Herald in 1926 as court and police reporter and later was assistant city editor. He wrote golf for the paper. As secretary of the Golf Association, he had been its handicapper and had arranged its tournaments since 1930. He was a member of Penobscot Lodge, F & AM, at Dexter and a former president of the Portland Newspaper Guild.

DENMARK - Elden Willard Burnell, 94, of Denmark, died March 17, 2006 at Bridgton Hospital.

Elden was born in West Baldwin on Aug. 24, 1911, the son of Fulton James and Essie Weeman Burnell. The family moved to Hiram when he was three years old. He attended Hiram grammar schools and graduated from Fryeburg Academy in 1931. He studied drum music for three years with the drummer in the Strand Theater Symphony Orchestra in Portland.

Mr. Burnell was elected to the Board of Selectmen of Denmark. He served for nine years, six of them as chairman. He was also a member of the Executive Committee of the Maine Municipal Association in Augusta from 1981-1983.

In retirement, he and his wife created a truck farm selling local vegetables for over forty years. They developed a Christmas tree plantation for retail sales on their 16 acres. Their customers and their gardens brought both of them great enjoyment.

Mr. Burnell was a member of Oriental Masonic Lodge #13 in Bridgton, a Past Master of Mt. Moriah Lodge #56 in Brownfield, and a member of the Denmark Congregational Church.

He is survived by his wife of 68 years Katherine Burnell; a brother Clayton Burnell of Burlingame, Calif.; several nieces, nephews, great-nieces, and great-nephews.
