Mr. Burr was a native of Natick, Mass., and the family moved a few years later to Auburn, where he received his education. He was for a time a clerk in a shoe plant there and then was in business with his father. He afterwards became New Hampshire supervisor for the Bradstreet mercantile agency. He resigned this position to become assistant superintendent and purchasing agent for the Sears Roebuck shoe factory at Springvale. While residing there he was a member of the Sanford school board and of the committee in charge of the erection of the High School building.

He came to Kennebunk in 1919, serving as purchasing agent for the Keyes Fibre Company and a few years ago he became local manager for the N. T. Fox Lumber Company. He was elected town auditor soon after he became a resident of Kennebunk and became town treasurer in 1926.

He was a member of the Masonic bodies, including the Knights Templar, of which he was past commander, the Odd Fellows' lodge in Auburn a director of the Kennebunk Building and Loan Association, was affiliated with the Kennebunk Fire Society and attended the Unitarian Church.

Ellsworth, Oct. 17.—Charles Rodney Burrill, 62, a lifelong resident of this city and one of its widely-known business men, died suddenly at 4 o'clock this morning as the result of a heart attack while at his home.
