BRUNSWICK - Clayton E. Butcher Sr., 79, of 12 Tufton St. died Monday at Mid Coast Hospital.

He was born at Lisbon Falls, son of William and Grace Durgin Butcher. He attended schools there and graduated from Lisbon Falls High School in 1929. He was a member of the class of 1934 at the University of Maine at Orono, and acquired additional credits from Columbia University.

Mr. Butcher was employed by US Gypsum Co., Lisbon Falls, as fabrication superintendent, maintenance supervisor and plant engineer. In 1945, he joined the Pejepscot Paper Co., Topsham, and on June 28, 1967, he was named general manager. He retired in 1977.

He married the former Bella M. Gagnon in 1935 and they lived at Lisbon Falls. Mrs. Butcher died in 1982.

After his retirement, he moved to the Clearwater, Fla., area, and summered in Monmouth.

On Aug. 3, 1983, he married Beatrice Henshaw Boyden. For the past three years they lived here.

He served a cubmaster for Pack 109 from 1949 to 1960, and was a former member of Lisbon United Methodist Church.

He was a 57-year member and former officer of the Ancient York Lodge, Lisbon Falls, and a member of several other Masonic organizations.

He was a charter member, past president and vice president of the Lisbon Rotary Club. He was a past president of the Lisbon Falls Library Association.

He enjoyed golfing and painting.

Found dead on the shore of Little Duck Pond, Windham, early Sunday night, Almus D. Butler, 73, of 85 Rackleff Street, retired chief of the Portland Fire Department, was declared the victim of a heart attack.

Dr. Daniel Mannix, medical examiner, said Butler died of coronary occlusion, with over-exertion as a contributory factor. He apparently was hauling in his rowboat when he collapsed and died. Butler had gone alone to the camp Sunday to store his boats for the Winter.

His body was discovered by his son-in-law, Fred E. Carpenter, and his grandson, Thurland C. Hall, who went to the pond to search for him when he failed to return to Portland.

Ex-Chief Butler had been a member of the department 25 years when

he retired in 1923. He entered service as a call man attached to Ladder One. Later he was made captain of Chemical One and Engine Five. In 1907 he resigned and entered the book binding business, being employed by the Bacon Manifold Company. In July, 1914, he was appointed fire chief and served in that capacity until his retirement.

He was a member of the Massachusetts Fire Chiefs Club and the International Association of Fire Engineers. After retiring as chief, he served for some time as manager of the Congress Square Garage.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Mildred Carpenter of Portland, with whom he lived, and Miss Marion Butler of New York City.

prominent figure in Portland sports

Donald O. Butler, 87, owner for 45 years of the James Bailey Co. sporting goods store in downtown Portland, died Saturday at the Barron Center after a long illness with Alzheimer's disease.

In the days before malls and giant sporting goods stores, Bailey's, just off Monument Square, was Portland's biggest sports store. Mr. Butler owned Bailey's from 1941 until 1974.

PASSAGES

Each day, the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

"Generations of athletes have bought their first piece of equipment there and kept coming back," said a 1974 Press Herald story about Mr. Butler's retirement.

"Fathers and grandfathers repeat the pleasant ritual, getting a big kick out of their young charges' delight at sighting the tempting display of bats, gloves, balls, uniforms, helmets, sticks, clubs and other

sports paraphernalia."

Bailey's was a natural gathering spot for athletic coaches and officials, and the store became a clearing house for sports strategies and ticket information.



"For a long time, it was the main sports store in Portland," said Dick Doyle, a retired Press Herald sportswriter. "Don went well beyond the boundaries of business in his service to local sports. He was generous in his credit to schools."

Bailey's was the supplier of custom uniforms for many local teams, from Little League to high school.

Mr. Butler took great interest in school sports, and was a longtime member of the Stadium Commission, which oversaw the management of Portland Stadium, now known as Fitzpatrick Stadium. If it snowed on Thanksgiving Day, it was his job to find a crew and clear the field for the game between Portland and Deering high schools.

Mr. Butler handled ticket sales for many sporting events at the Portland Exposition Building, and was also a sports promoter, bringing the Harlem Globetrotters to the Expo several times.

"I guess every kid who's ever played a sport hereabouts has come through that door sooner or later," Butler told a reporter in 1974. "Then they come in as grownups. ... To think that maybe we've helped them a little along the way, ... brings a great satisfaction."

Born in Portland, a son of Orion M. and Estella Ball Butler, he was a standout athlete at Deering High School. As a young man, he worked at the Casco Bank.

During World War II he was in the Civil Air Patrol as a flight instructor for Naval trainees.

He was a former president of the Portland Lions Club and Trefethen-Evergreen Association on Peaks Island. He was a member of the Woodfords Congregational Church, the Cumberland Club, the Woodfords Club and the Portland Country Club, where he helped establish the annual pro-member tournament. He was active in the Masons and the Shrine.

His wife, Blanche Rolfe Butler, died previously.

Surviving are two daughters, Ellen B. Russell of Yarmouth and Judith B. Nichipor of Trumbull, Conn.; four grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

A private service will be held, with burial in Evergreen Cemetery. Arrangements are by Jones-Rich & Hutchins Funeral Home, 199 Woodford St.

—Frank W. Butler, 69, prominent attorney and long identified with the affairs of this town, died this morning at his home following several months of failing health.

Mr. Butler was born in Phillips, Oct. 4, 1864, the son of Benjamin and Sarah B. Butler.
