BATH — Edward M. Butterfield, 70, of 30 Webber Ave., died today, Nov. 10., 1992, at his home as the result of complications from emphysema.

Born June 20, 1922, in Bath, he was the son of Andrew M. and Eleanor Cahill Butterfield. He had independent vision from birth causing him to see double when he looked at objects with both eyes. He attended Bath schools and graduated from Morse High School in 1940. He received a master's degree from the Yale School of Drama in theater design in 1945.

On June 8, 1945, he married the former Margaret K. Sampson.

He was employed at the former Hyde Windlass Company for 22 years as a repair manager.

In 1971, he received a master's degree in special education from the University of Maine at Farmington and taught special education in the

Brunswick school system until suffering a heart attack in 1980.

Mr. Butterfield was a member and former chairman of the Board of Deacons of the United Church of Christ Congregational, a member of the church choir and a former member of the church fair. He had acted and was director of many of the Bath Thespian productions. He was a former member of the Brunswick Chorale, a life member and past member of the Polar Star Lodge of Masons.

He was also an active member of the Bath High School Alumni Association, and had been coordinator for his class reunions. He was trustee and president of the Morse High School Scholarship Fund. In 1986, he received the Morse High School Mainsail Award, given to a Bath area person who made a major contribution at the school system and whose activities reflect favorably on the

school and community.

Besides his wife of Bath, he is survived by a sister, Elizabeth J. Coombs of Worthington, Ohio; and two nieces.

A memorial service will be held Sunday at 2 p.m. at the United Church of Christ Congregational, with the Rev. David C. Hall officiating. Burial will be in Oak Grove Cemetery in Bath.

FRYEBURG - Francis G. Buzzell, 91, a farmer, state agriculture official and president emeritus of the Fryeburg Fair, died Tuesday at a Lewiston hospital.

Mr. Buzzell was president of the West Oxford Agricultural Society, which puts on the annual Fryeburg Fair, from 1989 until 1992. Before that he was secretary and a trustee for many years.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

His first involvement in the fair came in 1915, when he showed his first pair of steers at age 12. In 1927 he was elected secretary and during the 1930s he served on the finance committee.

"He hadn't missed a fair for a long while," said his brother Donald. "He mostly enjoyed the livestock, but he was interested in all aspects of the fair. We showed cattle at fairs around New England while he was working for the

state. We did very well at it."

Mr. Buzzell and his brother worked the 1,500-acre Buzzell Farm on Route 5, which was established by their father in 1895. The farm specialized in registered Hereford beef cattle as well as potatoes, corn and beans.

"He was good farmer, friend and neighbor," said Philip Andrews, president of the fair. "He was a pleasure to visit with. At one time he and his brother had one of the largest registered Hereford herds in the U.S."

In 1943, Mr. Buzzell was elected to the Maine House of Representatives. A year after that he took a job as director of the Division of Animal Industries in the Maine Department of Agriculture. He held that job for 29 years, until his retirement in 1973.

Under his leadership, Maine was the second state in the nation to be certified free of brucellosis, in 1963, and free of animal tuberculosis, in 1967.

He was the first layman to become president of the U.S. Animal Health Association. "He was particularly proud of that," said his brother Donald. "Veterinarians had always been the head of that group."

Mr. Buzzell was a trustee of Eastern States Exposition, an agricultural representative to the New England Council for many years, and an honorary member of the American Veterinary Medicine Association.

He was active for many years in 4-H and he helped start the Baby Beef Club at the Fryeburg Fair.

In 1978, he received the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service Administrators Award from the U.S. Department of Agriculture. He also was awarded the Outstanding Alumni of Fryeburg Academy award a few years ago.

Born in Fryeburg, a son of E. Chandler and Edith Andrews Buzzell, he graduated in 1922 from Fryeburg Academy and in 1926 from the University of Maine.

A lifelong Fryeburg resident, he also kept a home in Augusta while he served in the Legislature and worked for the state. He moved last year to an Auburn nursing home.

He was a 32nd degree Mason, a 60-year member of the Pythagorean Lodge and a member of Kora Temple Shrine, as well as numerous state and regional livestock associations. He enjoyed fishing.

Surviving are his wife of 67 years, Irene Coburn of Auburn; three brothers, James of Groveland, Mass., Edward and Donald, both of Fryeburg; and a sister, Mary Pattberg of Bayonet Point, Fla.

Hodgdon C. Buzzell, 70, former president of Maine's Senate, died of a cerebral hemorrhage in St. Mary's General Hospital today.

Long a figure in Maine's Republican Party, Buzzell was stricken Saturday night in the stables at Lewiston Fairgrounds. Two of his horses raced at the fair last week.

Waldo County judge of probate since 1944, "Hod" Buzzell was the county's principal political figure for a quarter century.

He had been county attorney, city solicitor and mayor of Belfast and a member of both legislative houses.

Hillard H., one of his four sons, now is Waldo County attorney. The other sons are Charles, connected with a Boston bank, George of Brunswick, a state policeman, and Dr. Benjamin, a Saco dentist. He also leaves his widow, Nellie.

Born on a farm at Monroe, he taught school and sold insurance to make himself a lawyer, and he used his legal training as a background for politics.

He was elected to the state House of Representatives in 1917 and in the last of three consecutive terms was Republican floor leader. Then he won promotion to the Senate and in his second term was its president.

In 1926, Buzzell tried unsuccessfully to win his party's nomination to the U. S. Senate seat vacated by the death of Bert M. Fernald. Ten years later he announced his candidacy for Congress in the Second District but withdrew before the primaries because, he said, the field was overcrowded.

In 1939, Buzzell was returned to the Legislature as representative, and in 1942 was elected mayor of Belfast.

Gov. Sumner Sewall appointed him judge of probate in 1944 to fill an unexpired term. He subsequently was elected.

He was a 32nd Degree Mason, an Odd Fellow, a member of the State Grange and of the Knights of Pythias. He served the Pythians as grand vice commander in Maine one year.
