Kenneth S. Cadigan, 74, of 78 Lincoln St., died today in a local hospital following a brief illness.


He was born in Pittsfield, Mass., Feb. 9, 1889, son of Maurice H. and Hattie Francis Cadigan. He attended Bed-






Edward W. Cail




