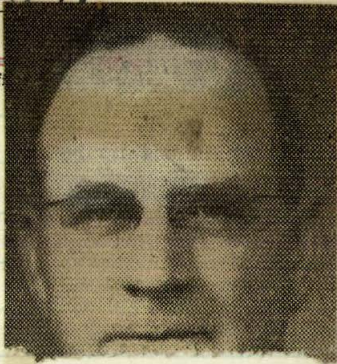

Dr. Harry H. Campbell, 55, of 28 Coyle Street, a practicing osteopathic physician here nearly 30 years and prominent in fraternal and service organizations, died suddenly here today of a heart ailment.

He had reported for work as usual this morning and was stricken about 10 a. m. in his office, 142 High Street.

Born in Akron, O., he was graduated from the Kirksville College of Osteopathy and Surgery, Kirksville, Mo. and started practicing in Portland about 1919.

He had been outstanding in his profession throughout Maine and in 1947 was awarded the distinguished service certificate by the Maine Osteopathic Association.

He was the third recipient of the certificate, awarded to the individual who has done outstanding work for the profession in the state.
