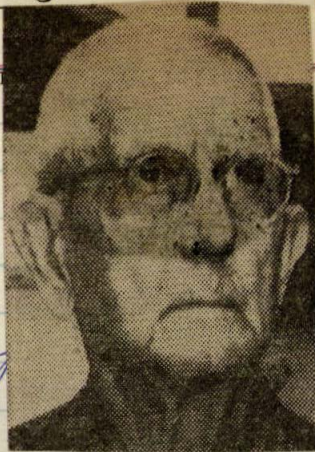

Harry H. Cannell Dies In Hospital

Harry H. Cannell, 64, of 171 Neal Street, former town official of Naples and practicing attorney here since 1915, died Monday in the Maine General Hospital, where he had been a patient five weeks. He was in failing health several months.

Born in Naples June 27, 1876, son of the late Philip O. and Lizzie Hall Cannell, Mr. Cannell was educated in the schools of that town and of Bridgton Academy. He served on the board of selectmen, assessors and overseers of the poor of Naples before coming to Portland, and read law in the office of the late A. H. and E. C. Walker in Bridgton and here with Connellan & Connellan. He was admitted to practice of law in Maine Feb. 8, 1915, and before the U. S. District Court a year later. Before practicing law he was a civil deputy on the staff of former Sherriff Melville W. Trefethen.

Mr. Cannell was interested in motor-boating and his hobby was hunting and fly-fishing. He had a summer cottage at Chebeague Island.

He was a member of Ancient Landmark Lodge, AF & AM; Mount Vernon Chapter, RAM; Portland Council, R & SM., and Portland Commandery, Knights Templar; also of the Cumberland County Bar Association.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Ivy Ricker Cannell, whom he married June 29, 1909; a son, Harry H. Cannell, Jr., and granddaughter, all of Portland; and a brother, George M. Cannell of Philadelphia.

SARASOTA, Fla. -- Thomas Cardente, of Falmouth, passed away peacefully on Dec. 25, 2007, after a long illness.

He was born in Providence, R.I., Aug. 6, 1921, to Attilio and Mary Scalini Cardente, and was one of 10 children. While attending school in North Providence through the 8th grade, Tom worked with his father, peddling fruit, to help support the family. At 18, he joined the CCC and was sent out West to help build the national parks in Wyoming, which he regarded as a great experience to meet other young people and to see the country. During World War II, Tom served in the Army as a mechanic for the motor pool. Later, he worked on cranes used for building war ships, while also working as fleet mechanic for Christianson's Dairy.

In 1943, Tom married Marjorie Turner, a former schoolmate, and resided in Providence until 1951, during which time their son, Douglas, was born. After the war, Tom started a business of picking up engines, starters and transmissions from New England junk yards and then selling them to rebuilding companies in Massachusetts and New York. During his travels, he fell in love with Maine and moved to Brunswick in 1951, where he founded Maine Auto Parts. As automatic transmissions became more popular, he began a second company in 1957, Portland Transmission Exchange, which at one time owned 17 divisions throughout New England and had over 100 franchised dealers. During this period, the company's manufacturing plant was in the old Pondicherry Mill, in Bridgton, Maine, and was one of the area's largest employers. Other companies that he started were the Bridgton Machine Company and the Surplus Cellar.

Tom began his real estate company, Arrow Realty, by buying properties that no one else wanted. Over his lifetime, he bought and sold over 60 properties. In the late 1950s, he began acquiring real estate in the Bayside area of Portland, which included the Buick Building and the Cushman Bakery Factory, which he renovated into Portland's first vocational school, Cookie Tech. Eventually, he purchased over 40 parcels in the area, which he called Government Center because the majority of the tenants were city, state and federal agencies. Government Center was later purchased by the Betty Noyce Foundation and is now called Bayside Center.

Tom was a hard worker and respected others that did the same. He was active in the business community until his late 70s, during which time, he was a 32 Degree Mason, served as Potentate's Aid for the Kora Shrine and was a member of Kiwanis.

Tom and Marj have resided in Falmouth Foreside and Sarasota since 1961. They belonged to the Portland Yacht Club for many years, where they enjoyed time on their houseboat, Summer Place.

Tom was a wonderful grandfather and spent special time with each of his three grandchildren. They gave him much joy. He and Marj taught them to roller skate and skated with them until both were well into their 60s.

Tom was predeceased by brothers, John, Albert and James Cardente and sisters, Louise Paolino and Angela Longo; and is survived by brothers, Joe and Eugene Cardente and sisters, Virginia Tiner and Anna Forgetta, all of Rhode Island. Pittsfield, Feb. 12—Gustavus H. Cargill, 86, one of the oldest permanent members of the Masonic Grand Lodge of Maine and a member of Liberty Lodge since 1870, died at his home here this morning.

A native of Liberty, Mr. Cargill had served that town as town clerk from 1872 to 1914, and he was postmaster there from 1897 to 1914. For about 45 years he was engaged in business at Liberty as a harness maker and he was a telegraph operator for between 10 and 15 years. Later he had a private line from Liberty to Belfast which was subsequently made a part of the telephone system.

He was for three years master of the Masonic Lodge at Liberty, had served as Deputy Grand Master of the Seventh Masonic District and junior warden of the Grand Lodge of Maine, and he was also affiliated with St. George's Royal Arch Chapter, Mount Moriah Council of Skowhegan and St. Elmo Commandery, Knights Templar, of Waterville.

Mr. Cargill came to Pittsfield in 1914 and had for some time served as janitor and general caretaker at the Public Library. Surviving are two sons, Walter N., a Boston electrical and mechanical engineer, and Dr. William L., Pittsfield dentist. There are also three grandchildren, Geraldine, Neal W., and Harriet Cargill.
