


While a resident of Westbrook, Mr. Carleton took a special interest in city affairs and served for a time as a member of the School Board.

CITY COUNCILOR Llewellyn Carleton of 107 Pine Street, retired business man and long active in City and State politics, died in the Maine General Hospital at 8.55 a.m. today. He was 73.

Last July Mr. Carleton submitted to a major operation, convalesced

and returned to his home in early and returned to his home in early September. The second operation, a necessary step toward his complete recovery, was regarded as wholly successful by his physicians. He was to have been discharged from the hospital Sunday. hospital to his home, he collapsed. He began to grow steadily worse and early Tuesday physicians despaired of his life. Mrs. Carleton, who has been under the care of a physician long before her husband's first operation, was not immediately notified of his death. Physicians feared that the news would complicate her

Mr. Carleton, founder and president of the Carleton Furniture Company, which he dissolved in 1933 after a successful business career, served in the Maine House of Representatives for three consecutive terms, from 1927 to 1933. The last two terms he was chairman of the important House, Appropriations Committee.

An ardent supporter of the councilmanager form of government and one

chairman of the last chairman of the council-manager form of government and one of the original sponsors of it in Portland, Mr. Carleton was widely known throughout the state after his entry into state politics. He was a strong advocate of economy in government and successfully prosecuted legislation which cut costs incident to each legislative session. He was an unsuccessful candidate for the State Senate in 1934.

A life-long Republican, he was one of the oldest members of the Portland Club.

He was born June 1, 1863, at Isle Au Haut, an island in Knox County and Must.

"The death of Llewellyn Carleton is cause for real sorrow, not only throughout this City but throughout the entire State.

"No one could appreciate his sterling qualities more than we who were with him on the City Council, where his sound judgment, his keen business ability, fearlessness and absolute honesty endeared him to all with whom he came in contact.

"He will be keenly missed at City Hall and the vacancy caused by his death will be very difficult to fill."


Mr. Carlisle was a father advisor of the DeMolay of Bath and attended Corliff Street Baptist Church.
