## Charles A. Carleton

Charles A. Carleton, 90, the oldest resident of Peaks Island and a retired employe of the S. D. Warren Company in Westbrook, died today at his home on Ocean View Avenue following an illness of a little more than a month. He was superintendent of the boiler department of the Westbrook concern for 30 years and then in the drafting department for a decade before retiring from active work in January, 1924.

Mr. Carleton was born in Portland, July 22, 1845. Following his education in the Portland schools he entered the employ of the Portland Company, going from there to the S. D. Warren Company.

In early manhood he married Miss Ellen Jane Sargent of Boothbay Harbor, who was prominent in club work in Westbrook during their residence there and later in the Calends Study Club of Peaks Island. He was a member of the Three-Quarter Century Club and took a prominent part in the club's outing held at the island a few years ago. He was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of the Portland Lodge, F. & A. M.; St. Albans Commandery, Knights Templar, and the Knights of Constantine, with other branches of the order. He also held membership in Bramhall Lodge, K. of P., in this city.

While a resident of Westbrook, Mr. Carleton took a special interest in city affairs and served for a time as a member of the School Board.

Besides his wife, Mr. Carleton leaves a daughter, Miss Mary Carleton, who resides with her parents, and two sons, Prof. Charles S. Carleton of Norwich University, Northfield, Vt., and William E. Carleton, who was for some years assistant state highway engineer of Virginia.

**CITY COUNCILOR** Llewellyn Carleton of 107 Pine Street, retired business man and long active in City and State politics, died in the Maine General Hospital at 8.55 a. m. today. He was 73.

Last July Mr. Carleton submitted to a major operation, convalesced and returned to his home in early September. The second operation, a necessary step toward his complete recovery, was regarded as wholly successful by his physicians. He was to have been discharged from the hospital Sunday. As his nurse was about to accompany him from the

hospital to his home, he collapsed.

He began to grow steadily worse and early Tuesday physicians despaired of his life. Mrs. Carleton, who has been under the care of a physician long before her husband's first operation, was not immediately notified of his death. Physicians feared that the news would complicate her condition.

Mr. Carleton, founder and president of the Carleton Furniture Company, which he dissolved in 1933 after a successful business career, served in the Maine House of Representatives for three consecutive terms, from 1927 to 1933. The last two terms he was chairman of the important House Appropriations Committee.

An ardent supporter of the council-manager form of government and one of the original sponsors of it in Portland, Mr. Carleton was widely known throughout the state after his entry into state politics. He was a strong advocate of economy in government and successfully prosecuted legislation which cut costs incident to each legislative session. He was an unsuccessful candidate for the State Senate in 1934.

A life-long Republican, he was one of the oldest members of the Portland Club.

He was born June 1, 1863, at Isle Au Haut, an island in Knox County. About 1890 he came to this City and became superintendent of the Atkinson House Furniture Company, Pearl and Middle Streets. Later, when the concern failed, Mr. Carleton became the owner and for years conducted the business on Congress Street.

His widow is his only immediate survivor.

### Funeral Saturday

Men with whom he directed the affairs of the City of Portland will serve as pallbearers at 2.30 p. m. Saturday when the funeral of Councilor Carleton is held at the residence, 107 Pine Street.

They include Councilors William J. Ward, Arthur E. Craig and Dr. Adam P. Leighton and possibly Chariman Edward C. Berry; City Treasurer John R. Gilmartin, City Clerk A. Edwin Smith and City Manager James E. Barlow.

Chairman Berry, ill at his home today, may be unable to attend the funeral. Notified of Councilor Carleton's death, Mr. Berry issued the following statement:

"The death of Llewellyn Carleton is cause for real sorrow, not only throughout this City but throughout the entire State.

"No one could appreciate his sterling qualities more than we who were with him on the City Council, where his sound judgment, his keen business ability, fearlessness and absolute honesty endeared him to all with whom he came in contact.

"He will be keenly missed at City Hall and the vacancy caused by his death will be very difficult to fill."
