TOPSHAM - Dr. Robert B. Carroll, 81, of 11 Coburn Lane, died Friday, Nov. 8, 2002 at Mere Point Center, Brunswick. He was born April 8, 1921, in Tuscaloosa, Ala., a son of Marvin McCoy and Floy Baker Carroll. He graduated from the University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa in 1941 with a B.S. in Chemistry, Metallurgy, and Ceramics. He received an additional B.S. degree in Agronomy in 1947, a Masters of Science in 1949, and his Ph.D. in Plant Pathology in 1951, all from Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge. He served in the U.S. Army, Corp of Engineers at Los Alamos, New Mexico, during World War II, where he participated in explosives research in weapons technology for the famed Manhattan (atomic bomb) Project. His working career began at U.S. Steel, Swann Chemical Company and Hercules Powder Company and following his military service, he worked as an assistant plant physiologist for the Boyce Thompson Institute and then as a microbiologist for the Borden Company before working as a consultant for 15 years. His clients included some of America's largest corporations. Doc as he was affectionately known, taught chemistry at the Brunswick School in Greenwich, Conn., and coached their rifle team to several state championships in the 1960's. He was also a chief range officer at the National Rifle Shooting Championships at Camp Perry, Ohio. Dr. Carroll developed a new method for the presumptive identification of dry substances suspected of being drugs of abuse and, as a result, in 1969, founded ODV, Inc., a company that manufactured kits employing this method. Dr. Carroll traveled world wide training numerous police agencies in the use of his kit. He moved ODV to South Paris, Maine in 1974, and sold the company to Michael Fiori in the late 1980's. He was a life member of the National Rifle Association, and served 29 years as an official referee and was active in developing rules and rule books for the association. Dr. Carroll had many professional memberships and was affiliated with Paris Lodge, #34, South Paris as a 32nd degree Mason. He loved flowers and serving his town of South Paris. He is survived by his wife, Sonya of Topsham, whom he married in November 1984. They moved to Topsham in April 1998; three sons, Dr. Robert Fulton Carroll and his wife, Betsy of Gainesville, Fla., Ray Carroll and his wife, Dora of
