ETNA - Crawford W. Carter Jr., 72, of Etna, died unexpectedly Monday at his lifelong home after a long battle with emphysema.

A son of Crawford W. and Bertha Wheeler Carter Sr., he attended Etna schools and graduated from Carmel High School in 1943.

He served in the U.S. Army infantry during World War II and was a prisoner of war in Germany from Sept. 1944 to April 1945. He received the Bronze Star, a Purple Heart and a Prisoner of War Medal.

He attended the University of Maine, graduating in 1950 with a bachelor's degree in education. He married Jean Dresser of Norway in 1949.

Mr. Carter worked as a mail carrier in Etna for 34 years, retiring in July 1980. He also worked with his father on the family dairy farm and continued to care for farm animals until the mid-1980s. With his father, he helped maintain Pleasant Hill Cemetery for many years, and also owned and operated an insurance agency.

Mr. Carter was involved with many civic and fraternal organizations, including the Etna Democratic Town Committee, the Etna Grange, and the Pomona, state and national Granges. He was Past President and Secretary of the Maine Rural Letter Carriers Association; Past Commander and Service Officer and most recently Adjutant of the West Penobscot American Legion Post 107 Etna-Carmel; and a member of the VFW Newport Memorial Post 1119.

Mr. Carter and his wife were club leaders of the Merry Workers 4-11 Club in Etna for 20 years. He was Past President of the Carmel High School Alumni Association and a director for the SAD 38 Elementary School. He was town meeting moderator for many years, and an active member of the Carmel Union Congregational Church, serving as deacon, trustee, church treasurer and Sunday school superintendent.

He was a member of the American Tree Farmers Association and a 50-year member of Benevolent Masonic Lodge #87 of Carmel.

Surviving are his wife of 48 years; a son, Scott of Falmouth; a daughter, Janet Winchester of Etna; a sister, Lancy Bradshaw of Pittsfield and Parker, Ariz.; a brother, Preston of Tacoma, Wash.; and several grandchildren.

Visiting hours are from 2 to 4 and 6 to 8 p.m. Thursday, with a Masonic service at 7:30 p.m., at Brown Funeral Home, 24 High St., Newport. A funeral will be held at 1 p.m. Friday in Carmel Union Congregational Church with the Rev. Mark Bruce officiating. A military committal service will follow in Pleasant Hill Cemetery.

Edward E. Carter, 83, of Hyattsville, Md., formerly of Bath, died Oct. 11, at Sibley Memorial Hospital there. He was a pioneer in forest conservation and one of the earliest supporters of conservationist Gifford Pinchot.

He was the son of Captain Christopher O. and Margaret Edgecombe Carter, formerly of 45 Green street. He graduated from Morse High School and received his B.A. from Bowdoin College in Brunswick in 1902 and a M.A. from the Yale School of Forestry in 1904. He also taught forestry at Syracuse University and was a fellow in the Society of American Foresters, the highest professional honor a technically trained United States forester can receive.

Mr. Carter joined the United States Forestry Service in 1905, the year the service was established. He later taught forestry at Harvard from 1910 to 1915, at which time he returned to the Washington office of the service. He was appointed assistant chief of the Forest Service in charge of timber management in 1920, which he held until he retired in 1945.

He was a strong advocate of tree planting and was responsible for establishing tree nurseries in the national forests. He also initiated the service's basic policies for timber sales.

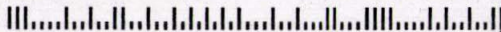
