

Caswell, 70, general and orthopedic physician here many years and head of the science department of Portland High School from 1891 to June, 1926, who died Tuesday morning in his home, 125 Spring Street, will be held at 1 p. m., Thursday, in Corinthian Hall, Masonic Temple.
