MILBRIDGE — Tech. Sgt. Charles E. Cashman, 66, USAF retired, died Sept. 8, 1980, at the Maine Coast Memorial Hospital, following a brief illness. He was born Oct. 22, 1913, in Brooklyn, N.Y., son of the late Edward and Elizabeth Cashman. He was educated in Northport, L.I., schools and attended Pratt Institute of Technology in New York. Sgt. Cashman served 27 years in the Air Force with duty in World War II, the Korean War, and Vietnam. His tours as a command photographer also placed him in Japan, Germany, India, and The Phillipines, the U.S. Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, and Walter Reed Armed Forces Institute of Pathology,

Washington, D.C. During the Lyndon Johnson administration, he was assigned to the White House as a staff photographer. Sgt. Cashman retired from the service in 1970 and lived with his wife, June F. Lisbon Falls, Sept. 13—Richard G. Caspar, 79, long connected with the Pejepscot Paper Company and widely-known in Central Maine, died at his Summer Street home today. He had been in ill health for several years.

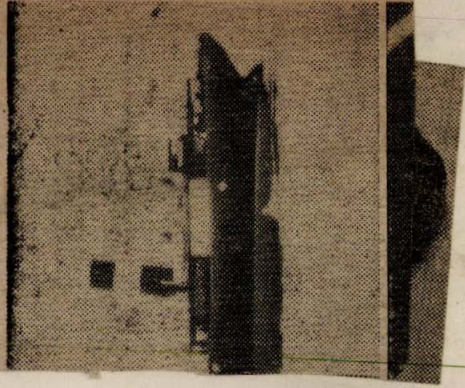

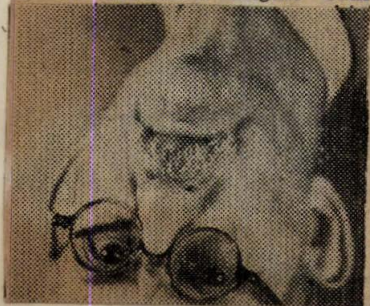

Funeral services for Dr. Charles O. Caswell, 70, general and orthopedic physician here many years and head of the science department of Portland High School from 1891 to June, 1926, who died Tuesday morning in his home, 125 Spring Street, will be held at 1 p. m., Thursday, in Corinthian Hall, Masonic Temple. Interment will be at Newmarket, N. H. For several weeks he had been in failing health.

Dr. Caswell was born June 26, 1866, at Newmarket and was graduated from Dartmouth College in 1890. He taught a year in the Hartford, Conn., Preparatory School and later entered the Maine Medical School.

Following his graduation in 1900 from the medical school, then a part of Bowdoin College, he began his practice of medicine. He was on the staff of the Children's Hospital and later on the staff of the Maine General Hospital. He trained and served as house officer of the Massachusetts General Hospital in 1908-1909.

At Portland High School he was sub-master of the school under William B. Jack, now superintendent of schools, and Arthur W. Lowe. Since retiring from school duties he had devoted his time to his practice.
