He married the former Doris Blake on June 14, 1947.



William Chamberlain, long a well known and highly respected citizen of Portland, died Saturday, in h's 90th year. Spending the Winter at the home of his son in Mt. Vernon New York, he fell in his 100m aud fractured his hip. Pneumonia developed and he became unconscious, passing away most peacefully with out knowing that he was near death.

Funeral services were held Sunday, in Mt. Vernon where all the family were present, including two sons, A. H. and W. R., and a daughter, Gladys, four grandchildren and two great grandchildren. His wife died in Portland in October, 1937, in the 63rd year of their married life.

Mr. Chamberlain was for 20 years treasurer and manager of the Emery. Waterhouse Company, with which he was connected for 45 years.
