## Arthur J. Chick

Special Despatch to Sunday Telegram

Monmouth, April 24—Funeral services for Arthur J. Chick, 69, for 40 years principal of Monmouth Academy here, were held this afternoon at his home, followed by burial in Monmouth Ridge Cemetery. Mr. Chick died Wednesday afternoon.

A former member of the House of Representatives and of the State Senate, he was chairman of the Republican town committee for 30 years; he taught mathematics with especial proficiency; was trustee of both Monmouth Academy and the State Normal Schools, and was a member of Monmouth Lodge, F. and A. M.; of Monmouth Grange, and of Boynton Chapter in the Eastern Star.

Principal Chick was born at Madrid, was graduated from Bates College, Lewiston; came to Monmouth Academy in 1901, and married Mabel

Millay of Bowdoinham the next year. She survives; also five daughters, Marion, a teacher at Westbrook, Doris, a teacher at Sharon, Mass., Gertrude, a teacher at Pittsfield, Annie of Monmouth, and Mrs. Fred Kinney of North Monmouth; three sons, George of Monmouth, Benjamin of North Monmouth, and Private Arthur J., stationed at Brooklyn, N. Y.; and seven grandchildren.

MONMOUTH - Arthur J. "Buster" Chick, 76, died Sunday at Nicholson's Nursing Home in Winthrop after a long illness.

He was born here, a son of Arthur J. and Mabel Millay Chick Sr. He was a 1934 graduate of Monmouth Academy, attended Maine Central Institute and was a 1939 graduate of the University of Maine at Orono, receiving a bachelor's degree in agriculture.

On April 4, 1951, he married Adelaide E. Russell at Vassalboro.

A World War II Army Air Force veteran, Mr. Chick was a sergeant in the 1330th Army Air Force Base Unit in the Burma and China Theater.

He had been a teacher at Freedom Academy and for most of his life was an orchardist. He was a founder of Chick Brothers Orchards, which later became Chick Orchards Inc. He was a company vice president and served on the board of directors.

Mr. Chick was a member and past vice president of the Maine Extension Association, a director for the Kennebec County Extension Service, a life member of the Pomological Society of Maine, a director of the New England Apple Council, a member of the Maine Labor Committee, a member of the Farmers' Home Administration and its advisory committee, a member of the Cobbossee Yacht Club and a founding member of the Cochnewagan Trailblazers Snowmobile Club.

He was a member and past King Lion of Monmouth Lions Club, a charter member of the American Legion Post, a member of the VFW Post, a 50-year member of Dirigo Grange, Freedom, and a member of the University of Maine Black Bear Club.

Mr. Chick was active for several years with the Monmouth Little League Association and the Babe Ruth Baseball Club of Winthrop. He was a member and past master of Monmouth Lodge of Masons.

Surviving, besides his wife, are a son, Keith of Readfield; a daughter, Mrs. Dwain (Kathy) Butcher of Winthrop; two brothers, George of Monmouth and Ben of Winthrop; four sisters, Marian Chick of Portland, Doris Chick, Mrs. Annie Pratt and Gertrude Chick, all of South Portland; and a granddaughter.

A funeral will be held at 1 p.m. Wednesday at the United Church. Burial will be in Maine Veterans Memorial Cemetery, Augusta. Arrangements are by Bragdon Flanders Funeral Home.

"I learned a lot about photography from him," said Joseph Quinn, a longtime friend. "He always had his eyes open, looking for stuff to take shots of. He was good at aerial shots."

From 1976-84 Mr. Chick and his wife ran a group home for teenagers. Before that they had been foster parents to more than 100 teenagers, mostly girls. Some they had only briefly, and others they cared for from a very young age until they were high school graduates.

"We still hear from some of them occasionally," said his wife.

The Chicks adopted two of the foster children when they reached their late teens. "We'd had them since they were nine months old," said Mrs. Chick. State regulations did not allow for the easy adoption of foster children at the time, so they waited until the children were older.

Born in Hermon, a son of Howard and Beulah Kimball Chick, he moved to Norway at a young age and graduated in 1944 from Norway High School.

He was a member of the Second Congregational Church, the Oxford Chapter of Masons and the Order of the Eastern Star, and the Stone-Smart American Legion Post.

While in the Navy during World War II, he participated in the invasion of Okinawa. He was active for many years in the Coast Guard Auxiliary, Portland.

Surviving, besides his wife of 42 years, are his mother of South Paris; two sons, David Chick of Portland and Craig Moody of Windham; three daughters, Roberta Wilner of Norway, Shelley Gravel of Yarmouth and Gail Brown of Waterford; and four grandchildren.
