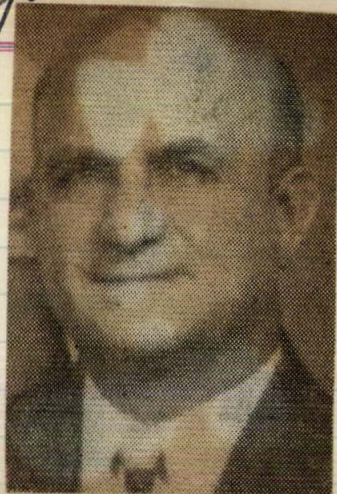

Mr. Christy delivered Meals on Wheels in Windham for seven years, and grew to be friendly with many of the people on his delivery route, said his wife, who also went along on deliveries.
