Westbrook, April 4.—Charles Sargent Clark, 71, a star fielder on the old Presumpscot baseball club of this city a half century ago, died this afternoon at Berlin, N. H., where he had made his home since 1890.

He was instrumental in organizing the Red Men here and was one of the first officers of the local tribe. He also was a member of Warren Phillips Lodge, F. and A. M., of Cumberland Mills and Presumpscot Valley Lodge, K. of P., of this city. He was a member of the Elks and the Rotary Club at Berlin, where he operated a stationery and sporting goods store. He also was a director of the Berlin Bank. His first employment here was with the Knowlton Machine

Company and he had been employed several years by the S. D. Warren Company before going to Berlin. He was born at Springfield, Me.

He was married twice, his first wife being Miss Jennie Louise Anderson of this city. He is survived by his widow.

Mrs. Susie Anderson Clark of Berlin, and a sister, Mrs. Claude Butterfield of Springfield.

Funeral services will be held at 2.30 p. m. Sunday at Berlin. Prayers will be said at 1 p. m. Monday at the grave in Woodlawn Cemetery here.

Mr. Clark was a door-to-door salesman for Fuller Brush Co. for 25 years in the Rockland and Camden area, and won numerous sales awards.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

"He never owned a car," said his daughter, Betty Lee Perham of South Portland. "He did it all on foot. On weekends, he would hire a high school boy to help him deliver."

"People couldn't comprehend how he could make it," she said. "Every day he would take the bus to Camden or Thomaston or Rockport and cover the area. He found it interesting and it gave him satisfaction in meeting people."

Mr. Clark's trombone career began when he was growing up in central Maine. He picked potatoes to earn money to buy his first trombone, and walked five miles each day for instructions.

He played the trombone in the Army band in the early 1920s and for Chandler's Band in Portland from 1930-1936. He also taught trombone for many years in Rockland and only retired from playing about 10 years ago.

In 1930, he married Frances Hassner. She died in 1963, and he married Dorothy Allen in 1969. His second wife died in 1975.

During the early 1930s, Mr. Clark lived in Portland and worked for Chipman's Grocery Store on Congress Street, and as a soloist for the First Radio Parish Church. After several years, he returned to Rockland and began selling Fuller brushes.

In the early 1960s, Mr. Clark returned to Portland and worked for several years at the Maine Medical Center in maintenance, retiring in 1969.

During his retirement, Mr. Clark established the Disabled Children's Fund, and raised more than \$10,000 toward that cause. In exchange for a donation, he used to give people hand-crafted items he made in his home workshop, such as napkin holders.

For his humanitarian work, Mr. Clark was nominated for a Jefferson Award, received a Volunteer Action Award from President Ronald Reagan, and was nationally recognized by the Rev. Norman Vincent Peale.

Born in Plymouth, a son of William Henry and Lenora Curtis Clark, he attended Detroit schools and took numerous extension courses.

He was active in the Masons for nearly 70 years, including King Solomon Lodge in Waldoboro and Hiram Lodge in South Portland. In 1984, he received the prestigious Simon Greenleaf Medal for distinctive Masonic service.

He was a member of the South Portland Moose Lodge and Rockland First Baptist Church and attended the Elm Street Methodist Church. He enjoyed gardening. Surviving are two daughters, Barbara Mills of Gorham and Betty Lee Perham of South Portland; six grand children and four great-grandchildren.
