Farmington, Feb. 19—Funeral services for George D. Clark, 79, long register of deeds for Franklin County, who died at his home here Friday afternoon following a long illness, will be conducted at the home on Court Street Monday at 2 p. m. Mr. Clark, who was president and a director of the First National Bank, was born at New Vineyard, the son of George W. and Bessie McCleary Clark. He was at one time county commissioner and had also served as first selectman of New Vineyard.

He had been register of deeds since 1906, with the exception of four years. He was a trustee of the Franklin County Savings Bank, a member of the Masonic Lodge, attended the Congregational Church and was president of the Farmers' Telephone Company.

COLLIER - Harold Clifford Clark, 101, a railroad yardmaster and World War I veteran who was active in the Masons, died Monday at Gorham House.

Mr. Clark retired in 1963 from Maine Central Railroad Co. after having worked there since he was a teen-ager. His father died young and he was raised by his mother from age 9. After his first year at Portland High School he left to take a job with Maine Central.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Since the railroad was his only job, and he had a railroad pension, Mr. Clark was one of only a few people in the United States without a Social Security number.



During World War I, he was an Army second lieutenant, serving as a platoon commander. He was honored last year by the Department of Veteran Affairs with a World War I commemorative medal on the 75th anniversary of the war.

Mr. Clark enjoyed singing and sometimes during conversation he would break into an old-time song, such as "Let Me Call You Sweetheart."

Harold Clark Morrison
"He sang for people wherever he was," said Morrison.

"My wife would say to me, 'you've got a good enough voice to sell fish,'" he said in a Press Herald interview last October.

"Harold was a walking history book," said John Matthews, a longtime friend. "He used to talk of going out to the country, on St. John Street and Brighton Avenue, and playing on the farms with the cows and the horses. That would have been around 1900."

Mr. Clark's mind remained sharp to the end, and he attributed his longevity to clean living. "In his mid- to late 50s he had a perforated ulcer," said his granddaughter, Catherine Brosdal. "I guess he came close to dying. The doctor said, 'Harold, you must give up smoking and drinking if you want to live.' I don't think he ever had another cigar or drink after that."

Mr. Clark was active for many years in the Hiram Lodge of Masons, South Portland. He was a past commander of the American Legion's Cumberland Barracks, which includes World War I veterans. He was a 35-year member of the United Transportation Union, and a past president of the Maine Association of Railroad Veterans.

He worked in a variety of jobs and eventually rose to the position of yardmaster.

During the years of passenger rail service, he was stationmaster at Union Station on St. John Street.

Mr. Clark and his late wife, Minnie Morrison Clark, enjoyed passenger train travel all over the United States. He called it a tragedy when Union Station in Portland was torn down, according to Ida Morrison, Mr. Clark's niece by marriage.

He lived for many years at 489 St. John St. before moving at age 96 to Dolley Farm Retirement Home in Westbrook. He lived seven years at Dolley Farm before moving last year to Gorham House.

He was born in Portland, a son of Edward and Laura Jane Stuart Clark.

Mrs. Clark died in 1985, and a daughter, Jane Lauten, died in 1976.

Surviving is his granddaughter of Wabasasha, Minn.

Isaac Clark, 66, a former Augusta resident and long a prominent citizen of Visalia, Calif., died July 4, at his home after a year's illness and funeral services were held July 7. As a tribute to Mr. Clark the chapel of the funeral home, where the services were held, was filled to capacity. The impressive Elks service was used.

Isaac F. Clark, long prominent in the municipal life of Deering and Portland, died suddenly this morning in his home, 24 Pitt Street, at the age of 101 years.

Remarkably active for one of his age, Mr. Clark was about the house Thursday. He arose this morning as usual and was dressing himself when he was stricken and died almost immediately.

His death removes one of the most picturesque characters from the life of Portland. Mr. Clark kept up his interest in local affairs to the last of his life. He retained vivid memories of many incidents which it was his delight to recall and relate to friends. He had held office in the former city of Deering and continued in Portland civic affairs after the annexation of Deering in 1897.

Interested in lodge affairs, he was a guest of Unity Lodge, IOOF, of which he was a member, at its 65th anniversary last February, and was presented a large birthday cake which combined recognition of his 101st birthday and the lodge anniversary.

Born in Portland Feb. 13, 1841, Mr. Clark lived in Westbrook in his infancy, and referred with interest to living in the town of Westbrook, town and city of Deering, and in Portland, and always all the time in the same school district. For many years he served as secretary of the Park Department of Portland, resigning at the age of 81 years on giving up active work. He was also two years superintendent of school buildings and supplies of the city.

His earlier activities included service as chairman of the last Board of Selectmen of Deering, and its first acting mayor, while for more than 30 years he was ballot clerk in the ward rooms of Deering and Portland.

He was a member of the Odd Fellows from 1870 on, a past grand of Ligonias Lodge and a charter member of Unity Lodge, and its agent 43 years, and several years treasurer of the Board of Agents of lodges in Portland, a charter member and past noble grand of the First Rebekah Degree (Ivy) Lodge instituted in Portland, and the last of the charter members.

A past grand representative of the Sovereign Grand Lodge, IOOF, he was also a member of the Veteran Odd Fellows Association of Portland, serving as its treasurer 23 years. He was for 71 years a member of Eastern Star Encampment, IOOF, a past chief patriarch and treasurer 30 years; also a member of the Patriarchs Militant Degree, a past captain and the first commander as well as charter member of Canton Ridgely of the Militant degree; a member of the Grand Encampment of Maine and past grand patriarch of the Grange Encampment of Maine, representative to the Sovereign Grand Lodge, K. of P., and a past chancellor of the Past Chancellors Association of Portland, as well as member of Bramhall Lodge, K. of P. He was a life member of Deering Lodge of Masons. Other organizations with which he was identified were the Sons of the American Revolution and Old Falmouth Chapter, Sons of the American Revolution, of which he was a charter member.

For many years he was a member of the Portland Provident Association, and of the Three-Quarter Century Club of Maine, in which he also held charter membership.

Surviving are three sons, Seth F. and Arthur W. of this City, and Frank W. of Melrose, Mass.; a daughter, Mrs. George A. (Rhena) Marsh of Scarsdale, N. Y.; five grandchildren, and three great grandchildren. Mrs. Clark died two years ago.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Monday at the Rich Funeral Home, 11 Mellen Street, and interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery.

John Albion Clark, 69, retired Bath Iron Works Corp., shipyard foreman, died Thursday evening at Bath Memorial hospital, where he had been a patient for two weeks.

He was born in Bath, the son of Melville B. and W. Maude Chaney Clark.

At the age of 15 he began work in the old Percy & Small yard at the South End, where the largest schooners in the U. S. Merchant Marine were built.

He went to work with the old Bath Iron Works, Ltd., in 1908, when the firm was building 700-ton destroyers.

Mr. Clark was one of the last of the Bath shipyard mechanics who began their long careers in a local yard, building wooden sailing vessels.
