MOSCOW — Laurel Oscar Clark, 84, of Moscow, died Monday, Feb. 3, 1997, at a Bingham nursing care facility.

He was born Sept. 2, 1912, in Limestone, the son of Oscar and Pearl (Brawn) Clark.

At the age of 15, Laurel came to the Moscow area looking for work. He was first employed as a teamster at a lumbering operation; he was later hired on the construction of Wyman Dam and worked there until the project was completed. He drove truck for the Kennebec Mill in Bingham and was a security guard at the Quimby Veneer Mill in Bingham until it closed in 1974. He was a school bus driver for many years.

Laurel served as a member of the school board for 22 years and has been a Health Officer and Constable for the town of Moscow for more than 30 years. He was superintendent of the Union Cemetery in Moscow for many years and had been a civil defense officer and animal control officer in the town of Moscow. In 1960 and 1961 he was appointed a State Humane Officer by Governor Reed.

He was a life member, past noble grand, and past district deputy of the Odd Fellows, a member of the Masonic Lodge, and a member and past King Lion of the Bingham Lions Club, a member of the Eastern Star and the Rebekah Lodge.
