Thomas Clegg

South Paris, Jan. 30. — Thomas Clegg, 65, well-known figure at Association Hall, where he had served as janitor and caretaker the past 25 years, died Wednesday in the Central Maine General Hospital, Lewiston, where he had been a patient since last Friday.

A native of Dublin, Ireland, he was born Aug. 25, 1881, the son of William and Elizabeth Mainwaring Clegg. He learned the carpenter trade in Ireland and in 1909 came to this Country and South Paris, where he had been employed the past 37 years as a woodworker by the Paris Manufacturing Company.

A year after his arrival here, he sent for his childhood sweetheart, Miss Jane Hickey, in Ireland, and they were married. He was a member of the Paris Lodge of Masons and Oxford Chapter. When Association Hall was built, Clegg temporarily took the position as janitor, and at the time of his death still held the additional job.

Surviving are his widow; three sisters, Mrs. Harry Williams of Hebron, Mrs. Lena O'Keefe of Dublin and Miss Elizabeth Clegg of Bristol, England; three brothers, Frank and Henry of Dublin and George Clegg of New York City; and a niece, Mrs. Isabelle Dewey of Washington, Ind., whom they brought up.

possible to check or control the fire without opening the fire door. In some cases it is advisable to install a check damper with an opening equal to at least two-thirds the area of the flue pipe. This check damper should be installed in the flue pipe on the chimney side of the turn damper.

It is also advisable to have a periodical inspection made of this type of plant in order to make sure that there are no leaks in the fire pot, the combustion chamber, or the flue passages. Such leaks would allow some of the products of combustion to escape into the hot air jacket and go into the house instead of being carried up the chimney. All such leaks should be sealed up immediately.



Jack, informed of Dr. Cleveland's not unexpected death, said: "He was a fine gentleman and one of the most useful members of the School Board it has been my pleasure to work with. His zest for hard work was an inspiration to us all; he never spared himself, and this industry and sacrifice, coupled with his sound judgment and great knowledge of the field that he made his own and in which he was an authority, erected for him a monument in our public school system which succeeding generations of children may admire and respect."

Dr. Cleveland was born in Mass., Sept. 3, 1872. He received his early education in the town of Massachusetts. His father was at Cushing Academy, Andover, N. H., from which he graduated in 1895, and at

School he earned as he went along, receiving a large part of the necessary funds from teaching and tutoring. He himself had taught two years in the grade schools of his native state and during his college course he taught Greek in the Williamstown High School. In 1910 he took a post-graduate course in medicine in London.

Establishing himself in practice at Auburn he served on that city's school board and he took a personal interest in educational affairs during the 25 years in which children from his own family attended public schools. Removing to Portland in 1920, he was elected a member of the Portland School Board for the first time in 1927 and for the last time in November, 1934.

Dr. Cleveland was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of the Knights of the Red Cross, of Constantine, Woodfords Club, and Club, Kora Shrine, Portland Golfers Club, Cumberland County and Game Association, Portland Golf Club, Cumberland County Medical Society, Maine Medical and

American Medical Association.
