

Bingham, Feb. 11—Forrest H. Colby, 69, of Bingham, woods manager for the Maine Seaboard Company, former manager for the S. D. Warren Company, and former Forestry Commissioner of Maine, died today at a Bangor hospital, where he underwent an operation earlier in the week..

Mr. Colby, who with Mrs. Colby, was passing the Winter in Bangor, became ill while attending to his duties with the Seaboard Company, in Washington County, and entered the hospital Monday.

He was born at Bingham, the son of Warren and Mary Colby, and practically all his life had been passed in the lumber business. He was chairman of the board of selectmen here for several years, and had served in the Maine House and Senate. He was a member of the Masons, the Knights Templar and of the Bingham Congregational Church.

In addition to his service with the Warren Company and the Seaboard Company Mr. Colby had also served the Kennebec Log Driving Company when a young man, the American Realty Company and the J. Manchester Haines estate, of which he was a trustee. He was long considered one of the best and most trustworthy scalers of lumber in Maine.

Mr. Colby leaves a wife, Mrs. Carrie Tobinson Colby; two daughters, Mrs. Joseph Swan of Bedford Hills, Conn., formerly of China, and Mrs. Myra Mitchell of China, who is at present in California, while her husband is looking after his business interests in the war-torn country. There are also four grandchildren.

Albert A. Cole, 84, oldest active grocer in the United States, died early this morning at his home at West Scarborough.

Mr. Cole, proprietor of a grocery store at 68 Sawyer Street, South Portland, had been in the grocery business since 1863. He was recognized as the oldest grocer by the National Association of Retail Grocers last year and was received by President Roosevelt on a visit to Washington.

He had been in failing health for several weeks.

He was born Dec. 3, 1853, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Roethus Cole, at Freeport. He started work as a grocery boy in 1863 and later became proprietor of his own store at South Portland.

Mr. Cole, who had lived to see great changes occur in the grocery business, estimated that he had given away \$75,000 worth of groceries in the course of his business career in volunteer charitable contributions.

Mr. Cole had served in the State Legislature and as a ward clerk. He was a past master of Hiram Lodge of Masons, a member of Greenleaf Chapter, Royal Arch Masons; Portland Council, Royal and Select Masters and the Maine Historical Society and was a past chancellor commander of Bayard Lodge, Knights of Pythias.

Prospect Harbor, Dec. 19—Colonel Casper W. Cole died at his home in Fort Lauderdale, Fla. Colonel Cole was a native of Prospect Harbor, born here on May 3, 1871, though part of his boyhood was spent in Watertown, N. Y.

While living in New York State, he became a member of the New York National Guard, and later at the outbreak of the Spanish-American war he volunteered for service and saw active duty in Cuba.

He applied for and received a second lieutenant's commission in the regular United States Army, after which he saw six years of foreign service in the Philippine Islands, and served in China during the Boxer Rebellion.

Colonel Cole was a graduate of the Army School of the Line and Mounted Service School at Fort Riley, Kansas. In World War I., he served in the AEF and rose to the rank of Colonel. He was retired at his own request after 23 years of service.

Colonel Cole was a 32nd degree Mason, and a member of the Masonic Lodge at Winter Harbor. For the last ten years he made his home on New River in Fort Lauderdale. He leaves in his immediate family his wife, Mrs. Geneva Milliken Cole and a sister, Mrs. F. D. Shaw of Nashua, N. H.

He was buried with full military honors at Arlington Cemetery, Washington, D. C. The service was most impressive. His life was lived in devoted and whole-hearted service to his Country, and he was only prevented from serving in this great conflict by ill health.

Colonel Cole's going is deeply grieved by many relatives and friends in this vicinity who have yearly looked forward with pleasure to his visits here during the Summer.
