KENNEBUNK, Aug. 10. (Special).—Charles H. Cole, 85, for 50 years in the insurance business here, died Sunday at the home on Dane Street. He was a native of this town and educated in local schools. In early manhood he lived in Boston four years and then returned to Kennebunk to become employed in a shoe factory. He opened a retail grocery store in 1881 and seven years later started the insurance business in which he was engaged until his retirement a few years ago.

He had served 10 years as town clerk, member of the School Board, 10 years treasurer of the Kennebunk Library and trustee of the Kennebunk Savings Bank. He was a charter member and past chancellor of Myrtle Lodge, K. of P., a past master of York Lodge of Masons, a past high priest of Murray Royal Arch Chapter, a charter member of Maine Consistory, Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite Masons, and a member and former trustee of the Congregational Parish.

Charles L. Cole, 72, a retired sea captain, of 43 Magnolia St., died Tuesday evening at a local hospital after a long illness.

Capt. Cole, who learned his seamanship aboard brigantines, was born May 24, 1884, at Deer Isle, son of the late Daniel J. and Susan Shepard Cole.

He attended Deer Isle schools and received his master mariner's license at Rockland. Capt. Cole spent 22 years under sail and exactly the same number of years steamboating before retiring in December, 1942. He went to sea at the age of 14.

After retirement from the sea, Capt. Cole entered the insurance business in Salem, Mass., leaving that about 10 years ago. Then he moved to the home of his daughter and son-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Cecil Ames, Portland.

In retirement, the captain took up gardening. He grew tomatoes averaging three-quarters of a pound with some of them weighing a pound and a half. Capt. Cole used a "secret" formula on his 300 tomato plants.

Capt. Cole was a member of the Congregational Church, Deer Isle Lodge, AF & AM, and the Eastern Star.

Survivors include three sons, Willis H., Lowell, Mass., Minott E. and Roger L., both of Portland; two daughters, Mrs. Bernice Varello, Lexington, Mass., and Mrs. Linnie M. Ames, Portland; two brothers, George H. Portland, and Eldridge G., Pasadena, Calif.; two sisters, Mrs. Vallie M. Thurston, Hartford, Conn., and Mrs. Christ Foote, Salem, Mass.; 11 grandchildren, five great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.





SCARBOROUGH - Gerald A. Cole, 92, recently of Piper Shores, Scarborough, passed away peacefully Feb. 1, 2006, at Maine Medical Center, Portland. Gerald was born Aug. 3, 1913, in Enfield, the oldest child of James Albert "A.J." Cole and Amy Stone Cole. He graduated from Bangor High School in 1932 and married Edwyna Cohan in 1934. The pair recently celebrated their 71st wedding anniversary. Gerald started driving his father's trucks in his teens. The family business, Coles Express, was his life's work, much of it as the company's senior vice-president. In 1941, he moved from Bangor to Portland, where he resided for the next 62 years. Gerald served both as vice-president and as a director of the American Trucking Association's Maine Chapter for many years. He served twice as president of the Maine Truck Owners Association (predecessor to the Maine Motor Transport Association). Gerald was very much a part of the development of the trucking industry in Maine. He was present when the road from Bangor to Houlton first was plowed in the 1930's. In 1959, when Alaska became a state, he and former Senator Ed Muskie brought truckloads of items from Maine to Alaska to welcome its residents to the union. On one occasion, Gerald and Edwyna hurriedly left a formal evening function during a storm to repair a broken-down truck, so that its cargo could be delivered on time. Edwyna in her gown holding the flashlight while Gerald in his tuxedo was turning a wrench must have been quite a sight! Gerald served on the Portland City Council for seven years and was elected to the Maine State House of Representatives in 1946. During and after the World War II, he served as Maine's disaster chairman, and was instrumental in obtaining Federal assistance to fight Maine's historic forest fires of 1947. Gerald's philanthropy has been extensive. He was a member of Rising Virtue Lodge No. 10, AF&AM in Bangor, of St. John's Commandery No. 3, K.T., in Bangor, of the Lodge Council Chapter Consistory of the Scottish Rite, Valley of Portland, of Anah Temple, A.A.O.N.M.S. in Bangor and of Put Stevens Court No. 107, R.O.J., in Portland. He also was a member of the Kora Shrine Club of Greater Portland, a member of the Kora Motor Corps and an associate member of Kora Temple in Lewiston. Gerald was a member of Unity Lodge No. 3 of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, in Portland. Gerald was a member of Woodfords Congregational Church in Portland. He also was a long-standing member of the Kiwanis Club of Portland, where he received the Distinguished Service Award in 2002. Gerald was honored by the Maine Health Care Association at a ceremony at the State House in 2005. Gerald is survived by his wife, Edwyna; by two children, Sandra Cole Parsons of Arizona and Kevin T. Cole of Portland; 10 grandchildren and several great-grandchildren; by two sisters, Winona Sawyer and Dorothy Warren, both of Bangor; and by two brothers, Galen Cole and Vaughn Cole, both of Maine and Florida. A memorial service will be conducted 11 a.m. preceded by an Odd Fellows memorial service at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, Feb. 4, at the Woodfords Congregational Church. Henry S. Cole, 60, of 12 Pitt Street, for many years an investments salesman and a resident of Portland 45 years, died Monday night in a local hospital. He had been in failing health since 1932.

James A. Cole, 80, of Limington, who conducted dancing schools in Saco and Ossipee River towns more than 50 years, died in the home of his daughter, Mrs. Blanche E. Clough, at 99 Revere Street this morning. Learning to play a "fiddle" as a child, and at the age of 16 he was playing for dances and teaching dancing. He continued in the calling 60 years. Mr. Cole never took a musical lesson nor learned to read music but played "by ear," being in his section what the late Mellic Dunham was about Norway.

Known far and wide as Jim, he was "bowing a fiddle" six nights a week every winter season for 50 years in numerous town halls.

His home, on a farm at Limington, was only a few hundred yards from the Cornish line on the Ossipee Trail. He was born there August 23, 1854, one of a family of six.

A Yankee in traits and by traditions, he was a carriage and sleigh salesman for many years, driving through the farming towns for miles around, hauling new vehicles behind

his wagon. He knew practically everybody, young and old, wherever he traded or fiddled.

He was stricken seriously ill 20 years ago and surgeons abandoned a major operation when they decided it would be of no avail. He recovered within three months and had been in excellent health until last November, when he was taken ill in the home of his sister, Mrs. Jennie Hall of Dover, N. H. He came to the home of his daughter here in January and had been kept to his bed two months.

Mr. Cole removed to Cornish village nearly 20 years ago. He purchased a fine residence which he sold after the death of Mrs. Cole and since had lived in the Cornish House. He was a member of the Masons.

Other near surviving relatives are a son, Guy, of Wenham, Mass., and several grandchildren. Funeral services will be held in the Methodist church at Cornish Thursday afternoon at 2.30 o'clock, conducted by the Rev. Daniel I. Gross of Athol, Mass., formerly pastor at Cornish and in this City.
