ALFRED HAVEN COLWELL

DEER ISLE Alfred Haven Colwell, 75, died March 2, 1991, at his home in Deer Isle. He was born Feb. 6, 1916, at Hancock, the son of Charles S. and Emma (McCrellis) Colwell. He attended Hancock schools and graduated from Exeter Academy in Exeter, N.H. While at Harvard University in Cambridge, Mass., he was active in football and baseball. For two seasons he played in the minor league for the St. Louis Cardinals. He coached Little League teams and was a player/coach for the Island Town Teams for several years. He was a 42-year member, secretary for 18 years, and a past master of Marine Lodge No. 122 AF & AM of Deer Isle. He was a district deputy for the Grand Lodge of Maine AF & AM. He was a member of the Acadia Chapter No. 31 of Ellsworth and a former member of Pine Tree Chapter, where he was a high priest. He was a member of the Blanquefort Commandery No. 13 of Ellsworth, King Solomon's Council of Belfast, Anah Temple Shrine of Bangor, Advisory Council of the Island DeMolay, Hancock County Shrine Club and

the Hancock County Past Masters Association. He was a member and past patron of the Harborview Chapter No. 136 OES of Deer Isle. He was a scout master for the Island Troop, Boy Scouts of America and served as trustee in the Deer Isle school system. With his brother, Albert, he owned and operated Colwell Brothers Lobster Business in Stonington until his retirement in 1981. He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Catherine (Stratton) Colwell of Deer Isle; two sons, Richard Colwell and his wife, Rosemary of Colorado Springs, Colo., Thomas Colwell and his wife, Paula of Deer Isle; three daughters, Nancy and her husband, Pearl Eaton of Deer Isle, twins, Clarice Hampton and Claire Davis, and her husband Peter, all of Coral Springs, Fla.; six grandsons, six granddaughters and six great-grandchildren; two brothers, Albert Colwell of Irvington, N.Y., and Charles Colwell of Hancock; three sisters, Gladys Donahue of Caribou, Mildred Stevens of Albion and Caroline Parkhurst of Boothbay Harbor; several nieces, nephews and cousins. He was predeceased by a brother, Arthur Colwell.

PROSPECT HARBOR, Aug. 11.

(Special)—Funeral services for Capt. George W. Colwell, one of the pioneers in Maine's lobster industry, were held at his home here today.

Captain Colwell died at his home in this Hancock community Monday after a heart attack. He was 83.

A native of Steuben, he was the second man in the United States to build a lobster pound and he was one of the first men to visualize the possibilities of marketing lobsters nationally. In 1896 he built his first pound on Dyer's Island and a few years later constructed another one there. Later he built two pounds at Hancock where he was for many years in business with his son, the late Charles Colwell of Hancock.

He started lobstering at the age of 14 and when he was 21 he acquired his own smack, the Dolphin, and went into business for himself. At the age of 69 he went into partnership with his son and five years later they sold the business to the Consoli-

dated Lobster Company and his son stayed on as manager. A grandson, Albert Colwell, now manages the business.

Capt. Colwell was married to Lucretia Gay of Machias and last Winter they celebrated their 58th wedding anniversary. They spent the past Winter with their daughter, Mrs. Wright, of McLean Street, South Portland.

He was a life member of Winter Harbor Lodge, Masons, and of the Schoodic Lodge, Knights of Pythias.

Besides his widow and daughter, he leaves a son, Dr. Harvard E. Colwell of Lincoln; a sister, Mrs. Charles Race of Hudson Falls, N. Y.; and a brother, Frank Colwell of Birch Harbor.

Bill Compston spent all of his life on or near the sea. A native of Liverpool, England, he often spoke of his childhood when ships filled the eight miles of docks on the Mersey River. He also recalled with great fondness long bike trips into northern Wales with his co-workers. After leaving school, he served an apprenticeship with local bakers and confectioners. He enlisted in the British Merchant Navy when World War II was declared. By the end of the war, he had risen to the rank of Chief Steward and Purser in the Clan Lines, headquartered in Glasgow, Scotland. His wartime service took him to the far corners of the globe, with occasional trips to the United States. In Portland, he met Marion Ferguson, a local teacher and Scottish piper, whom he married in Liverpool shortly after the war. The couple initially settled in England, but soon returned to the Forest City. After just a few years, they were able to purchase their own business, Compston's Bakery, across from Lincoln Park, which Bill operated until the mid-sixties. During that time, he organized and served as first president of the Maine Retail Bakers' Association. The city's plans for urban renewal led bill to close his business. Rather than re-locate, he decided it was time to return to the sea. He joined the American Merchant Marine, sailing as Chief Confectioner for the Grace Lines for nearly a decade. An experienced manager as well as baker, he ended his career as New England District Manager for Country Home Bakery. Although he never lost his English accent, his 'Limey' sense of humor, or his love for his homeland, Bill became an American citizen at the earliest opportunity and developed a deep affection for his adopted country. He particularly loved summers at the family camp on Bonny Eagle Lake, where he spent many hours swimming, boating, and water skiing with family and friends. From the time he settled in Maine, he belonged to various Masonic organizations. He cherished his membership in the Portland Commandery Escort, participating for many years in the annual Easter ceremonies. Bill and Marion had two children, William I. Compston, who lives

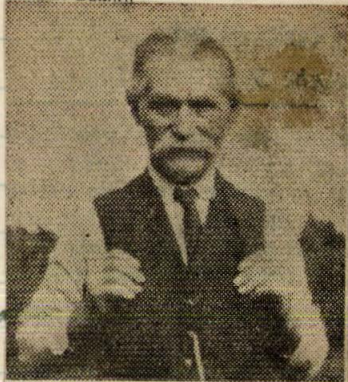
