F. Gilbert Congdon, 79, former owner of Congdon Transportation Co., died Tuesday at his home at 5 Pineloch Drive after a long illness.

Mr. Congdon was the owner, vice president and treasurer of the trucking company, which was started by his grandfather in 1885. Congdon's delivered bundled

newspapers statewide for the former Guy Gannett Publishing Co. from the 1920s until about five years ago. It also ran the Deering Junction Warehouse, just below Morrill's Corner in Portland.

Mr. Congdon took over the company in 1954 after the death of his father, and ran it until he retired in 1994. During that time, he also was the owner of Northgate Bowl-A-Rama, a bowling alley at Allen's Corner.

His grandfather started the business by

offering a horse and wagon for hire out of his barn on Lincoln Street at Woodfords Corner. When his father took over in 1919, a young Gilbert backed the trucks in and out of the barn before he was old enough to drive,

said his wife, Barbara Parsons Congdon.

Congdon's later had a truck terminal at 509 Forest Ave. before building a terminal and warehouse on Canco Road.

At its peak, the company had more than 100 trucks in several terminals across Maine.

For many years, getting the newspapers delivered was a way of life for Mr. Congdon, his wife said.

"He grew up with the business. It was in his blood, and he couldn't imagine doing anything else. You had to get the papers there, no matter what."

In the years he managed the fleet, he would get called out at all hours if there were truck breakdowns, accidents, delays.

During World War II, Mr. Congdon saw action in the Army's 1st Ranger Battalion in Europe and later drove a tank in the 20th Armored Division.

He was in the first group of Allied soldiers to reach Munich, Germany, and German soldiers were approaching his tank group by the score trying to surrender, his wife said.

Born in Portland, a son of F. Gilbert Sr. and Helen Milliken Congdon, he graduated in 1939 from Deering High School, where he was captain of the football team for two years. He also played football and competed in fencing at Worcester (Mass.) Academy.

Mr. Congdon was a past president of the Maine Truck Owners Association, a life member of the Woodfords Club, a member of the Woodfords Congregational Church, Deering Lodge of Masons, Portland Commandery, Kora Shrine, Portland Kiwanis Club, Portland Associates, Deering Associates, Society of Mayflower Descendants of Maine and the Highland Lake Association.

At age 60, he received his private pilot's license. He enjoyed traveling throughout North America, Europe and China, and also enjoyed going to Las Vegas.

Surviving are his wife of 49 years, Barbara Parsons Congdon; a son, F. Gilbert III of Portland; three daughters, Priscilla Congdon of Waldoboro, Patricia Grover of Portland and Pamela Springer of Windham; two sisters, Barbara Littlefield of Raymond and Virginia Congdon of Portland; and seven grandchildren.

Visiting hours will be from 4 to 7 p.m. Thursday at Jones, Rich and Hutchins Funeral Home, 199 Woodford St. A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. Friday with the Rev. Donald Drake officiating. Burial will be in Pine Grove Cemetery, Falmouth.

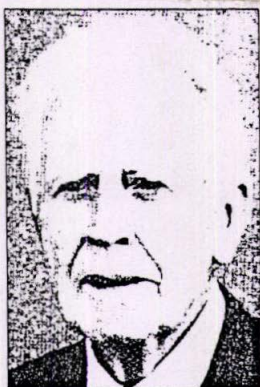
He came to Maine in 1915 to work in the engineering department of the Maine Central Railroad. He then built a shipyard in Bath for the Texas Steamship Co.
