SOUTH PORTLAND — Henry Linwood "Lin" Cook, 84, a television engineer and amateur radio operator, died Tuesday at a Portland hospital.

PASSAGES

Each day, the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

For 22 years, Mr. Cook was an engineer for WGAN-TV, Channel 13, retiring in 1976. He worked evenings, switching between commercials and local and national broadcasts, and was an engineer for many years during Channel 13 newscasts at 6 and 11 p.m. He also sometimes worked at the transmitter in Raymond, and did remote sports broadcasts.

"He came with us just when we went into TV, in 1954," said Lyman Brewer, former chief

engineer at Channel 13. "He was a great fellow, always cheerful and very dependable. He was an asset to the organization."



Henry L. Cook, 84, died Tuesday at a Portland hospital. Today there are hundreds of taller towers.

"He was self-educated," said his son, Thomas Cook. "He got into ham radio at a young age. Ham radio led to the engineering job."

Mr. Cook received his amateur radio operator's license in 1936, and for over 50 years he communicated all over the world from out of his home. His call letters were W1JRS, and he went by the name "Cooke" over the air. He often communicated by using Morse code.

He was a member of the American Radio Relay League, Portland Amateur Wireless Association and Yankee Radio Club. He had also helped some sightless people get involved in amateur radio operation.

He was a 30-year member of the South Portland Call Company Fire Volunteer, Engine 5, at Cash Corner.

"It was all volunteer, but he drove the truck and fought the fire," said his son. "He fought the forest fires of 1947."

Born in South Portland, a son of Thomas Henry and Imogene (Natalie) Barter Cook, he attended South Portland schools.

He was in the Civil Air Patrol during World War II, rising to the rank of warrant officer in the Radio Division.

Before working for WGAN, he was a mechanic and inter-service manager for Brown Motors and Bodwell & Leighton.

Mr. Cook was a member of the Hiram Lodge of Masons, Knights of Pythias, Three Score Plus Club, and the AARP. He also enjoyed hunting, fishing and trailer camping.

"He helped me a lot at wiring our new transmitter in Raymond," said Carl Mason, another engineer and friend. WGAN's television broadcast tower on Brown's Hill in Raymond was built in 1950, and was for a short while the tallest man-made structure in the world. At 1,619 feet, it was 154 feet taller than the Empire State Building. Six weeks later the tower was eclipsed by 40

He lived at 109 Ridgeland Ave. Before that he lived many years at 708 Highland Ave. and before that on Broadway near Cash Corner.

Surviving are his wife of 61 years, Marjorie Annie Morse Cook of South Portland; two sons, Thomas H. of South Portland, and George M. of Gossell, Vt.; eight grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.
