His most outstanding achievement as a firefighter, Portland Fire Chief Carleton E. Winslow Jr. said Sunday, was when Mr. Cooper courageously led three firefighters through a burning tower to the 10th floor of the former Eastland Motor Hotel (now the Sonesta Hotel) in Portland where they rescued guests trapped in their rooms.

Although Cooper and his men ran out of oxygen, they were able to

the building by placing them on an aerial ladder without serious injury to guests or themselves, Winslow said. The fire took place Nov. 16, 1981. Mr. Cooper had to be treated at the scene by Medcu ambulance for smoke inhalation.

Shortly after he joined the fire department, Mr. Cooper became a member of its elite drill team, which staged public demonstrations at a building on Park Avenue, Winslow recalled. Drill team members scaled the building and rappelled off its roof.

Orono, Feb. 10—Funeral services for Lamert S. Corbett, Dean of Men at the Univeristy of Maine since 1929, will be held at 3.30 p. m. Sunday at his home on College Avenue.

Dean Corbett, who headed the department of Animal Industry from 1913 to 1939, died Thursday in a Bangor hospital after a short illness. He was within a few days of his 58th birthday.

A native of Jamaica Plains, Mass., Dean Corbett had been in the service of the University since 1913. He was a graduate of the Massachusetts Agricultural College at Amherst, with the B. S. degree, and was awarded the BSA degree from Boston University in 1909 and the M. S. Degree from University of Kentucky in 1913.

After a year with the United Fruit Company in foreign service, he became assistant professor of animal industry at the University of Kentucky, and a short time later, in 1913, was appointed professor of animal industry at the University of Maine. After 26 years as head of the department, during 10 of which he was also dean of men, he resigned his post in the Agricultural College to devote his time to his duties as dean. He served also as chairman of the University Health Service.

For many years he was chairman of the Athletic Board. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge, of the Alpha Zeta honorary agricultural fraternity, and of Phi Kappa Phi, general honorary scholastic fraternity.

Surviving are his wife; two children, Alan, a University of Maine graduate now veterinarian on the faculty of University of New Hampshire and a daughter, Mrs. Thomas Barker, also a graduate of Maine, who with her son are now living in Orono while her husband is in the armed forces.
