## **ALBERT E. CORNISH**

Albert E. Cornish, 79, of 101 Pleasant Ave., oldest living past master of Atlantic Lodge, AF&AM, died unexpectedly yesterday after he collapsed at 547a Congress St., where he was employed as elevator operator.

Mr. Cornish was born Sept. 21, 1876, at Lisbon Falls, son of Daniel E. and Sarah Bibber Cornish. He came to Portland as an infant. His father was a well-known tailor. He attended Portland schools and later studied accounting and drafting. He married Ethel Libby, who survives, on Oct. 8, 1902.

He was associated more than 20 years with the Portland Stove Foundry, retiring in 1941. Besides his association with Atlantic Lodge, he was a past high priest of Mt. Vernon Chapter, RAM, an honorary member of Portland Council, and a former member of the Portland Club.

## Raymond C. "Reddy" Cotton

HIRAM - Raymond C. "Reddy" Cotton, 94 years of age of Hiram, died Wednesday at the Sun Rise Care Center in North Conway, N.H., after a long illness.

Nathan Wood of Pembroke, Mass. one granddaughter, Amy R. Irish and two great grandchildren, Shannon and Shane Irish all of Hiram.

The family received relatives and friends Saturday evening at the York Funeral Chapel, Maple Street, Cornish. Mr. Cotton's step son officiated at the funeral service at 7pm. Interment will be in the Hiram Village Cemetery.
