Arthur N. Couri, 57, of 12 Kenwood St., an automobile dealer here many years, active clubman, prominent yachtsman and bank director, died this morning in a local hospital after a long illness.

He was president of the Couri Motor Co., which he and his brother, Dewey, found in 1929. He was one of three prominent New England automobile dealers selected to help OPA Director Leon Henderson set prices for cars during World War II.

He served as director of the National Automobile Dealers' Association, as a member of the General Motors Dealers' Council and assisted in formulating policy with Oakland-Pontiac officials in Detroit in 1931.

Mr. Couri was past president of the Portland Automobile Dealers' Association, director of the Maine Automobile Association and member of the Portland Lions Club, Cumberland Club, Portland Country Club, Portland Yacht Club, Casco Bay Power Squadron and several Masonic bodies, including Deering Lodge, St. Alban Commandery, Knights Templar, Kora Shrine and the Jesters.

Portland Yacht Club expanded considerably under his direction as commodore for two years. He was past commander of the Casco Bay Power Squadron. He also was one of the instructors of the squadron, teaching seamanship, safety afloat and navigation.

He had been a director of the

Casco Bank & Trust Co. since it was organized in 1933.

Mr. Couri had been in the automobile business for 25 years. He was sales manager of the Cadillac Motor Co. for 10 years before opening his own Motor Co. in 1929. He was the best local auto dealer, operating under the name of Couri's and managing the business.

He was born July 1, 1898, in Saco, son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Bshara G. Couri. He attended local public schools and was graduated in 1916 from Portland High School. He played football, basketball and baseball. He was a member of the football team. He attended the University of Maine, where he played varsity football.

He entered the navy as a seaman in World War I and was discharged with the rank of ensign. He married the former Miss Louise R. Sparrow of Portland in 1919.

Their only son, Lt. Robert A. Couri, 24, USMC, was killed during the first assault of the Fourth Marine Division at Iwo Jima in 1945.

Besides his widow and brother, he is survived by a sister, Mrs. M. J. Thabet of Charlestown, West Va.; a daughter, Mrs. Walter F. W. Hay; and a grandson, R. Couri Hay.

Charles E. Cousins, 80, for many years a patrolman here, died Wednesday at his home, 299 Stevens Avenue. He served 37 years on the force before his retirement Sept. 18, 1930.

He was born July 22, 1858, at Harrisville, Wis., and first came to Maine when he was 20 years old. He was in the lumber business at Fryeburg with his uncle before he obtained employment with the Maine Central Railroad as fireman on the Mountain Division. He was promoted to engineer and held this position until he was appointed to the police department by Mayor James P. Baxter in 1893.

For 20 years he did active street duty, covering every beat in the city and becoming one of the most widely known patrolmen in Portland. Later he was turnkey at Police Headquarters. His last 12 years on the force was deskman at Station Two, Woodfords, since abolished.

At Woodfords he nearly lost his life in a struggle with a deranged woman who broke into the station one afternoon and slashed his throat twice with a razor before he subdued her. In his youth he was regarded as one of the fastest runners on the force and gained fame by capturing several criminals by his speed afoot.

Since his retirement under the police pension plan, he had lived quietly at his home.

He is survived by a sister, Mrs. Mary E. Merenus of Richmond, Va., and by two nephews, Ralph W. Cousins of Westbrook and Richard Gaffner of Fryeburg.
