Dr. F. A. Cousins Dies At Guilford

Funeral To Be Held Tuesday At Dexter

Special Despatch to Sunday Telegram

Guilford, May 15—Dr. Forrest A. Cousins, 74, for 40 years a practising dentist here, died suddenly this afternoon at the Mayo Memorial Hospital, Dover-Foxcroft, after several months of failing health.

Dr. Cousins was born at Dexter, March 29, 1869, the son of Isaac and Eliza King Cousins. He was educated in the public schools of that town and was graduated from the Philadelphia Dental College in 1899.

He practised in Philadelphia for four years and then returned to Maine and settled in Guilford in 1902. He was a member of Mount Kineo Lodge, F. and A. M.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Edith Drew Cousins; and a son F. Erwin Cousins of Portland.

Private funeral services will be held at the home Tuesday afternoon, with interment in the family lot in Mount Pleasant Cemetery, Dexter. Friends are asked to omit flowers.

TUCSON, ARIZ. F. Erwin Red Cousins, 90, died March 22, 1992. He was born in Philadelphia, Nov. 22, 1901, to Dr. Forrest A. Cousins and Edith Mae (Drew) Cousins. He graduated from Guilford High School, Guilford, Maine, in 1919, and Phi Beta Kappa from Bowdoin College in 1924. He worked for the Guy Gannett Publishing Co. for 41 years, retiring in 1966 as business editor of all five Maine newspapers of the Guy Gannett Publishing Co., and was known as being a first class writer and editor. He wrote a tri-weekly column for the Portland papers with the bi-line "The Party Line" under the pen name of Franklin P. Lincoln. He moved to Arizona after his retirement. His interests were history, archeology, rock hounding, astronomy and geology. He was a supporter of Audobon, nature conservancies, Maine and Arizona historical societies and the Flandrau Planetarium. He was a member of the Westerners in Tucson and the Mount Kineo Masonic Lodge in Guilford. He was an avid sports follower at the University of Arizona. His thirst for knowledge never ceased and was fed in his later years by non-fictions, provided by the Talking Book program. For five years, he had clouded peripheral vision due to macular degeneration and cataracts, but remained very active. He will be remembered for his keen sense of humor, wise decisions and being a very good friend to all. He was predeceased by his wife, Alice (Flaherty) Cousins. Surviving is his wife, Betsy (White) Cousins of Tucson, formerly of Guilford. Memorial services will be held in Tucson, March 28, 1992, with the Rev. Jon Ierley of Catalina United Methodist Church officiating. Cousins Funeral Saturday

Funeral services for H. Wright Cousins, 41, of 18 Wolcott Street, who police said shot himself Thursday morning with a .38 caliber revolver will be held at 2.30 p. m. Saturday at 795 Main Street, Westbrook. Interment will be in Eastern Cemetery, Gorham. Medical examiner Joseph. E. Porter gave poor health as the reason for Cousin's suicide. Dr. Porter said he had talked with two physicians contacted by the victim within the past week. Cousins was found unconscious in the office at Brink's Inc. protective agency at 22 Mounment Square, where he was a part-time employe. by Charles Mann, company manager. He died in the Maine General Hospital, where he was rushed by police ambulance. Cousins, a resident of Portland for 23 years, came here from Fryeburg, where he was born March 9, 1905, the son of the late Hendon and Eliza Osgood Cousins. Before coming to Portland in 1923 he attended Fryeburg Academy. In Portland he attended the old Portland University. He was a member of Central Square Baptist Church, Cornerstone Lodge, F and AM, Greenleaf Chapter and Portland Council. He also was a member of the Knights of Pythias at Fryeburg. He is survived by his widow, Esther Howe Cousins, a son, William H. Cousins, both of Portland; and a brother, F. Gerry Cousins, Bangor.

Harry W. Cousins, 76, of 1066 Congress Street, a dealer in real estate and formerly superintendent of the sheet metal shop at Rigby, died Monday in a local hospital of a fractured skull. Police, who took him to the hospital, after he was found lying on the ground at his home, believe he may have fallen from a ladder. They learned he intended to repair the roof, and a ladder was leaning against the building nearby.

Mr. Cousins was born June 16, 1876 at Buxton the son of Winfield S. and Mattie Allen Cousins. He was educated in the schools of the town and took up the sheet metal trade as a young man, becoming superintendent of that work for the Boston & Maine Railroad at Rigby.

After retiring, about 20 years ago, Mr. Cousins went into the real estate business. He was a member of the Woodfords Congregational Church, Atlantic Lodge of Masons and Fraternity Lodge of Odd Fellows.
