Dr. F. A. Cousins Dies At Guilford

Funeral To Be Held Tuesday At Dexter

Guilford, May 15—Dr. Forrest A. Cousins, 74, for 40 years a practising dentist here, died suddenly this afterncon at the Mayo Memorial Hospital, Dover-Foxcroft, after several months of failing health.

Dr. Cousins was born at Dexter, March 29, 1869, the son of Isaac-and Eliza King Cousins. He was educated in the public schools of that town and was graduated from the Philadelphia Dental College in 1899.

He practised in Philadelphia for four years and then returned to Maine and settled in Guilford in 1902. He was a member of Mount Kineo Lodge, F. and A. M.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Edith Drew Cousins; and a son F. Erwin Cousins of Portland.
