Ralph W. Cousins, 59, safety supervisor in the Portland office of the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company 10 years, died suddenly Thursday afternoon a few minutes after he reached his home, 25 Monroe Avenue, Westbrook.

Leaving his work early to return home, he was stricken with a heart attack upon arrival, collapsed and died before medical aid could be summoned. He had been afflicted two years ago with a heart ailment but appeared to have regained good health.

Mr. Cousins was born at Fryeburg, son of the late Wright and Ella Heath Cousins, was graduated from Fryeburg Academy and came to Westbrook 36 years ago. After brief employment by the Cumberland County Power & Light Company, he worked several years in the Electrical Department of the S. D. Warren Company.

Twenty-five years ago Mr. Cousins became wire chief in the Westbrook office of the telephone company, a position he held until he was transferred to the Portland office 10 years ago. He served several terms as City electrician.

PORTLAND -- William H. Bill Cousins, 76, of Bethel, and Higgins Beach, Scarborough, died Sunday, July 15, 2007, at Maine Medical Center.

He was born on Dec. 28, 1930, in Portland, the only child of Esther Howe and Harmon Wright Cousins. Bill attended Portland schools and graduated with the class of 1948 at Deering High School and Boston University. He served in the U.S. Air Force for four years as a drill instructor during the Korean War. In 1953 he married Margaret Lenti and together had three children.

Bill taught math for 34 years at Gould Academy in Bethel. He also coached football and soccer. He was a longtime member of the Bethel Masonic Lodge and past master. He was moderator of the Bethel town meetings for many years. For 15 years he was a weekly volunteer for the Maine Handicapped Skiing Program at Sunday River. Bill was president of the Higgins Beach Association for many years. Every 4th of July he would head up the cookout and parade for hundreds of children at Higgins Beach.

Bill was known for his friendly disposition, ability to talk to all people, his booming voice and his large presence. He was a man of integrity, compassion, and honesty.

Funeral services for Frank I. Cowan, 59, attorney general of Maine from 1941 through 1945, and long a prominent figure in city, county and state political and legal affairs, will be held at 3.15 p. m. Wednesday at 749 Congress Street, and interment will be in Pine Grove Cemetery, Falmouth Foreside.

Mr. Cowan, who died Monday in a local hospital after a short illness, had been, at various times, high school teacher, law school instructor, insurance firm president, Municipal Court recorder, state representative and an active member of the city's legal profession.

Born at Palmyra, he attended Maine Central Institute, was a graduate of Bowdoin College and the University of Maine Law School in 1917.

During college years, he taught at Plymouth High School, at Newton, Mass., Technical High School, 1913-14, and Calais Academy in 1914-15.

He was admitted to the Maine bar in 1917, and practiced in Bangor before moving to Portland in 1918. He carried on his practice alone for seven years before joining his brother, Walter A. Cowan. In 1940, he was joined in his practice by his son, Caspar F. Cowan.

One of his last acts as attorney general was an investigation of con-

ditions at Augusta State Hospital which was followed by a medical consultant's study of the hospital at the direction of the Maine commissioner of institutions.

In 1931, Cowan took part in an investigation and audit of Maine State Trust funds. His efforts resulted in return of about \$1,000,000 to the State.

From 1935 to 1940, Cowan was president of the State Mutual Fire Insurance Company. He was also director of the Aroostook Mutual Fire Insurance Company.

His political career began in 1920 when he was elected to the city's Common Council. He became president of that body the next year and served two terms.

He was appointed Portland Municipal Court recorder in 1926 and held the post until 1931. He ran but was defeated for Cumberland County Attorney in 1934 and for the State Senate in 1936. In 1938, though, he was elected to the State House of Representatives for a term. The Legislature chose him as attorney general in 1941. He returned to private practice after declining to accept a third term.

Cowan was a member of the American and Maine Bar Associations and the National Association of Attorneys General. He founded the Cumberland Legal Aid Bureau under auspices of the County Bar Association. He later became state secretary for the New England Legal Aid Council and the National Association of Legal Aid Organizations.

A 32nd degree Mason, he was member of Deering Lodge, No. 183, AF&AM, and other branches of the Order; also of Kora Temple, Mystic Shrine; the Woodfords, Bowdoin, Lincoln, Kiwanis and Eastern States Mountain Clubs.

Surviving are his widow, Helen Caspar Cowan; three sons, Caspar, Frederick W., West Stewartstown, N. H., and Douglas R., Portland; and a daughter, Cynthia, Portland; a brother, Walter A., Houlton; a sister, Mrs. Alice C. Osgood, Portland; a stepmother, Mrs. Ella J. Cowan, a half brother, Herman J. Cowan, and a half sister, Miss Sara J. Cowan, all Portland.

Ellery William Cowperthwaite

logger, farmer, shipbuilder, laborer

READFIELD - Ellery William Cowperthwaite, 94, of Kents Hill died Monday at the Glenridge Nursing Home after a long illness.

A logger, farmer and laborer, Mr. Cowperthwaite spent much of his life tied to the land. It was a legacy he shared with his sons through colorful stories about his hardscrabble days in the logging camps and the people he met there.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

"He was a simple person, uncomplicated, and he'd want to be remembered that way," said Stephen Cowperthwaite of Mt. Vernon, his youngest son. "He was extremely generous. Both my parents were. We certainly weren't rich, but I thought we were because they were always giving things away."

Mr. Cowperthwaite was born in Monticello on July 6, 1902, the son of

William and Laura Nason Cowperthwaite. He attended Monticello schools until he completed the eighth grade and went to work. From late spring until early fall, he worked on the family farm. Winters and early spring were spent working at his grandfather's logging camp, where he cut old growth spruce near Oxbow and braved the icy waters during the log drives.

"His great education came on the logging camp. All his life he talked about the characters he met," his son said. He talked of "Jillpokes," Partucides, and cookies and peavies, the dingle and Lombard hauliers, bringing the logging camp to life.

In September of 1925 he married Georgia Greene, who had come from New Brunswick to teach in Monticello. Early in the marriage, they lived briefly in Boston, where Mr. Cowperthwaite worked for one of his uncles, a builder.

The Cowperthwaites built a house at the corner of the family farm, and the growing family survived the Depression on \$9 a week, money Mr. Cowperthwaite earned working in a mill and hauling logs for his uncle Al Nason.

With the outbreak of World War II, the family left the farm for South Portland, where Mr. Cowperthwaite helped build Liberty ships and fishing vessels.

Not long before the end of the war, the family left the city and went back to the land; this time to a farm in Readfield.

Mr. Cowperthwaite also worked as a day laborer for his uncle John Nason, Giles building and the Highway Fence Co. "He worked so hard and he was so strong. Anyone who hired him for a day's work got a bargain," Stephen Cowperthwaite said.

In 1955, the Cowperthwaites sold the farm and moved to their brick home in Kents Hill.

Gardening, canning vegetables, tending to the flowers, and keeping the lawn trimmed kept Mr. Cowperthwaite busy during his long retirement.

He was also a member of the Lafayette Masonic Lodge of Readfield and the Torsey Memorial Church at Kents Hill.

Mr. Cowperthwaite leaves his wife Georgia, a sister, Reta Wotton of Littleton; three sons, Merrill of Westbrook, Frank of Alexandria, Va., and Stephen of Mt. Vernon; 11 grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren.

A celebration of his life will be held in August when family from afar can attend. A graveside service will be held at 1 p.m. Thursday in Village Cemetery, Monticello. Arrangements are by Roberts Funeral Home, Winthrop.
