Dr. Charles L. Cragin, 89 Dies After Long Illness

Dr. Charles L. Cragin, 89, of 829 Congress St., died this morning at his home following a long illness.

A retired prominent physician, he had practiced in Portland for 60 years.

Arthur E. Craig, who retired as chairman of the Portland City Council in 1939, died yesterday in a local nursing home.

Mr. Craig was 84 years old and made his home at 20 Atlantic St. He had been in failing health for about a year.

He was in the wholesale grocery business in Portland for 65 years, retiring from the Hannaford Brothers Co. in 1951.

A native of Portland, he went to work for the H. S. Melcher Co., wholesale grocers, at 16 and was president of the company when it became a division of Hannaford Brothers.

Mr. Craig served on the City Council for ten years, two of them as chairman.

He was a strong supporter of the council-manager form of city government. His election in 1929 and his re-election in 1934 were both hailed as victories for the manager form of charter.

Mr. Craig previously had also served two terms as a member of the Common Council from Ward One with the late Mayor

James P. Baxter under the old form of city charter.

As a city councilor, he was also for two years the local administrator for the Federal Economic Relief Administration in the early 1930s.

Beside being a supporter of the council - manager charter, Mr. Craig was praised in a 1938 Press Herald editorial for suggesting a careful study of Portland's traffic problems, including parking and the arrangement of one-way streets.

Mr. Craig attended Portland schools. He was a Mason, and was active in the affairs of the Congress Square Universalist Church.

He and his wife, the former Adelaide Starbird, celebrated their 62nd wedding anniversary this April.

Surviving, besides Mrs. Craig, are a son, John W. Craig of Portland; a daughter, Mrs. John Farnsworth of Waterford, the former Phyllis A. Craig; a brother, Augustus C. Craig, and a sister, Mrs. George Gould, both of Palo Alto, Calif.
