MACHIAS, July 2. (Special). — Frank T. Crane, 74, prominent in community affairs and engaged in the pharmacy business for nearly 60 years, died Wednesday in his home on Charles Street, where funeral services were held this afternoon.

A native of this town, Mr. Crane was graduated from the Massachusetts School of Pharmacy and associated with the R. T. Crane Company from 1886 to 1942. He was a former member of the Maine Pharmaceutical Association and for 15 years a member of the State Board of Pharmacy.

He had served as trustee of the Machias Savings Bank, chief of the fire department, fire commissioner and a Washington County jury commissioner. He was a member of all Masonic bodies and a charter member of Machias Chapter, OES.

LIVERMORE — James F. Cranford, 71, of River Road, Livermore, died at his home Tuesday morning following a lingering illness.

He was born May 25, 1920 in Corinth, Miss., the son of Bert & Jane Duncan Cranford. He was educated in Meadville, Pa. schools and took education courses while he served in the U.S. Navy. He married Nina Karlson of Arlington, Mass., July 31, 1942.

Mr. Cranford served in the U.S. Navy for 30 years and was a CWO-4 when he retired in 1972. He was recruiting officer in Burlington, Vt., for three years and in Portland two years before retiring. Mr. Cranford and his wife moved to the Livermore area over 20 years ago. He was employed at Forsters Mfg. for a short time before going to work for the State Department of Labor as a labor investigator. He retired in 1982 from the State of Maine.

He was a member of Sibert Lodge in the Panama Zone and Tranquil Masonic Lodge AF & AM of Auburn, Kora Shrine, Kora Highland Pipe Band, St. Andrew's Society of Maine, and Clàn DONNACHAIOH Society of

New England. He was a private pilot with a commerical rating and a former member of the Aircraft Owners and Pilot Association. When Mr. Cranford retired from the Navy he was checked out in a F-4 Phantom as a retirement gift. He was a scuba diver and headed a diving team in the Navy. He was a charter member of Livermore-Livermore Falls Historical Society, a former member of the Civil Air Patrol in Portland, and a member of the Disabled American Veterans chapter of Augusta. He was an avid reader and enjoyed wood working.

He is survived by his wife of Livermore; two daughters, Mrs. Gene (Pamela) Sinclair of Oxnard, Calif, and Mrs. Candace Johnson of Harrison; two grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Harold I. Craven chef, co-owner of Gray restaurant

SOUTH PORTLAND - Harold I. Craven, 83, a longtime restaurant chef and former owner of Towne-Lyne Restaurant in Gray, died unexpectedly Monday at his home on Cooper Street.

Mr. Craven's restaurant career began at age 12 when he landed a job at the Brass Rail in Bangor. "He started

out peeling potatoes and washing dishes," said his son, Ted Craven. "That was before the child labor laws we have today."

He later worked for Pilot's Grille in Bangor before moving to South Portland during World War II.

Mr. Craven worked at several restaurants in the Portland area, including 12 years as a chef at Valle's Steak House.

"When he started with Valle's, they had the small place at Woodfords

Corner," said his son. "He also worked at the Valle's at Oak Hill (Scarborough) before that one burned down."

After Valle's, Mr. Craven worked for a while at the Bridgeway Restaurant in Knightville, and then at Portland Country Club, Falmouth, where he was a chef for about four years.

Everywhere he worked, Mr. Craven was known as a hard worker who put in long hours. "He worked 16 or 18 hours a day," said his son. "He never took very many vacations. He just loved what he did, and he was good at it."

Before retiring Mr. Craven was co-owner and chef for several years at Towne-Lyne Restaurant on Route 202 in West Gray. The Towne-Lyne is a 200-seat, family style restaurant which he co-owned with his son.

"He specialized in preparing meat and potatoes and seafood," said his son. "All Maine dishes. He didn't grow up with these exotic French-type recipes. He was good at basic foods and seafoods."

Born in Bangor, a son of Theodore and Effie Brown Craven, he attended Bangor schools.

Mr. Craven lived 40 years on Cooper Street, and before that he lived many years on Pine Street in Ferry Village.

He was a member of the Masons.

His wife, Barbara Stone Craven, died in 1978, and a son, Howard "Jack" Craven, died in 1967.

Surviving are two sons, Ted R. Craven of Portland and Joel C. Craven of Richmond, Va.; seven grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
