SURRY - Vernard C. Crockett III, 60, died Monday Dec. 25, 2000, in Surry. He was born November 9, 1940, in Blue Hill, the son of the late Valerie (Grindle) and Vernard C. Crockett Jr. Vern graduated from Ellsworth High School in 1958. He then graduated from the University of Maine at Machias, where he served as class president, with a degree in education. He received both his Master's Degree in education and his Post Doctorate Degree in education from the University of Maine at Orono. He spent 30 years in education, serving as teacher, principal, assistant superintendent, and superintendent of the Bucksport school system. He was a finalist for Maine Elementary Principal of the Year, served on the executive board of Maine Teachers Association, was instrumental in the design and construction of the Miles Lane School,

Bucksport, and the development of the Special Education program for the school system. He served as Hancock County Commissioner from 1994-1998. He was on the Board of Directors of the Bucksport Regional Health Center. Vern was a member of the National Rifle Association, the American Horse Shows Association, the Bucks Mills Rod and Gun Club, the St. Croix Masonic Lodge, and worked on the Ellsworth Alumni Association. Vern loved the outdoors, was an avid outdoorsman, and being outside was what truly made him happy. He spent many hours at his remote hunting camp in Wesley. He was a licensed Maine Guide and was a true conservationist, acting as president of the Patten Pond Environmental Association.

He is survived by his wife of 37 years, Florence (Bonness) Crockett of Surry; his daughter Rebecca Crockett of Orland; his stepbrother Charles Crockett and wife Mary of Webster, N.Y.; several nieces, nephews, and many friends.

A memorial service will be held 11 a.m. Friday, at the Miles Lane School, Bucksport, with the Rev. Peter Remick, officiating.
