## Leon F. Cummings, Grocer Official, Dies

Leon F. Cummings, 60, of 124 Pleasant Street, for 15 years treasurer of the Cummings Brothers, Commercial Street wholesale grocers, died Friday afternoon in the Maine General Hospital. **South Portland, Sept. 27.**—Ralph P. Cummings, civil engineer and a former State representative and member of the South Portland board of aldermen, died Sunday in his home, 34 Craggmere Avenue, after an illness of several months.

## William H. Cumming

### honored as pharmacist, weather observer

HOULTON - William H. Cumming, 102, of Elm Street died Wednesday at his residence. He was the father of Alexander Cumming of Saco.

Born in Sherbrooke, Quebec, a son of Alexander and Maud (Jordan) Cumming, he moved to Houlton in 1894. He attended Houlton schools and the former Ricker Classical Institute there.

At the age of 18, he started work at the S.L. White Drug Store and a year later, moved to Munro's Drug Store. In June of 1914 he became a registered pharmacist at age 21, then the youngest in the state.

He was a member of the 2nd Maine Infantry for three years where he was a qualified sharpshooter.

He was employed at O.F. French Drug Store from 1938 to 1944, when he bought out the Munro Drug Store and opened the West End Drug Store. In 1968 he sold the store to Plaza Pharmacy, where he continued to work until he retired in 1972 at the age of 80. He worked for 62 years in the pharmaceutical field.

He was the oldest living member of the First Baptist Church of Houlton, where he served as deacon and taught Sunday school for years.

Mr. Cumming was a cooperative weather observer for which he received John Campanius Holm awards in 1964 and 1972 and the National Weather Service Edward H. Stoll Award in 1985 for 50 years of service.

He was a 75-year member of the Monument Lodge of Masons and a licensed ham radio operator (WINSN) for 55 years. On Sept. 12, 1978, he received the Thomas Jefferson Award. He also was honored with awards from the Aroostook Pharmaceutical Association in 1964, the Houlton Chamber of Commerce in 1976 and a Community Citizen Award in 1981 from the Houlton Grange.

His wife of 50 years, Margaret (Martin) Cumming and his daughter, Edith L. Cumming, both died previously.

Surviving are a son, Alexander of Saco; a daughter, Lois J. Cumming of Houlton; four grandchildren, Bruce G. Cumming of Chelmsford, Mass., Bonnie Dalton of Morrill, Janet and Bruce Ticker of Alfred, and Susan and Ronald Fortucci of Easton, Md.; and four great-grandchildren.

## GEORGE S. CUNNINGHAM

ORONO — George Snowdeal Cunningham, 84, husband of the late Evelyn L. (Cole) Cunningham, died Dec. 19, 1993, at a Bangor hospital. He was born in Whitefield, March 25, 1909, the son of Warren E. and Ella (Snowdeal) Cunningham. He was Professor Emeritus from the University of Maine, Orono, who earned his BA and MEd from the University of Maine and completed post-masters work at both Boston University and Harvard College. Although his principle career had been as an educator, he was also a master printer, ship builder and mold maker. Mr. Cunningham was general manager of the Empire Coil Company, New Rochelle, N.Y. and Danbury, Conn. He began his career in education as principal of Maine schools in South Bristol, Rockport, Biddeford and Leavitt Institute in Turner Center. Mr. Cunningham served as director of Mathematics Education for the State of New Hampshire in Concord and as Director of the Greater Cleveland, Ohio Mathematics Program. He retired from the University of Maine after 12 years as Professor of Mathematics and had continued his association with the University as a teacher of teachers and children. A longtime avid chess competitor, he was an enthusiastic teacher and tutor of young people in this field. Mr. Cunningham was tournament director of Maine Scholastic Chess Competitions, high school and college. The winner of the state competition receives the George Cunningham Trophy each year. He was active as director and manager of the University of Maine and the Bangor Chess Clubs from the mid 60's. A member and official delegate from Maine for the U.S. Chess Federation, he served that organization as Volunteer Executive Director, treasurer, vice president, member of the Ethics Committee and represented the U.S. at International chess meetings. He had been a trustee of the U.S. Chess Trust for over 10 years. Mr. Cunningham was author of a weekly chess column for the Bangor Daily News for 26 years. He was a longtime member of the Independent Congregational Society (Unitarian) of Bangor. He

served as president of the congregation and trustee of its endowment fund. Active in community service, he was a member and chairman of the Orono School Committee. Mr. Cunningham was a member of the Orono/Old Town Kiwanis; a member and

past master of the Penobscot View Grange of Glen Cove; a member of St. Paul's Masonic Lodge No. 82 of Rockport, Scottish Rite Bodies Valley of Rockland, Maine Consistory 32nd Degree Valley of Portland, the King Hiram Council No. 6, Rockland, and the Knights Templar, Rockland. He was a member and past patron of the Harbor Light Chapter OES No. 137 of Rockport; member of the Democratic National Party, League of Women Voters, National Organization for Women, National Council of Teachers of Mathematics (former president), Mathematics Association of America, National Society for the Study of Education and the Association of Teachers of Mathematics. He was the author of a number of articles and books, among them Key Topics In Mathematics. ## Ronald (Russ) Cunningham

1922-2002

UNITY — Ronald (Russ) Cunningham, 80, died unexpectedly Tuesday, May 14, 2002, in Woburn, Mass., at the home of his daughter, Jeanell Cunningham. Russ was born in Lisbon Falls, April 20, 1922, the son of Lewis and Thelma (Smith) Cunningham. Russ was the widower of Jeanette Jones Cunningham, his wife of 40 years when she died in 1989.

Russ grew up in Lynn, Mass., and moved to Maine in his early 20s and spent the rest of his life as a resident of Unity. Russ and his father-in-law, Cliff Jones, were the founders of Jones & Cunningham Oil Co., otherwise known as J&C Oil. They sold out to Webber Oil in 1964 and Russ continued to work there until he retired in 1984. He loved people and people loved him in return. It was a common occurrence to go to a restaurant and have his former customers approach him about solving their heating dilemmas on a cold winter's night. He developed lasting friendships with many because of his caring nature and his willingness to help those in need.

Throughout his life his most enjoyable times were spent either on the lake in Unity at his camp or traveling to and sailing on the ocean. He was always at home when he could sit at camp with his family and friends and participate in whatever lively conversation was at hand. Russ loved to be with people and hear of their adventures and also enlighten those around him with the stories of his life. It was never boring to spend an evening with Russell, especially if he indulged you with stories of his boat racing days, ice boats or sailing with small craft warnings on the Atlantic. Russ was a man who never needed to say much to drive his point home. His

keen wit and dry humor always involved some thought from the listener before an appropriate reply could be made.

Russ was extremely skilled with his hands and many that knew much about the trades would consider him a master of many. He was licensed as an electrician, plumber, and Master oil burner. He was also a skilled builder and his hobbies included boat building. He built many of the boats he used to race on the local circuits. He built a sailboat that he used on Unity Lake for many years. He also built one of the first houseboats ever to float on the lake.

Russell was a lifetime member of the Church of Christ in Unity. He was also a member of the Star of the West Lodge No. 85. He received his 50-year medal in 1999.

Survivors include his children, Jeanell Cunningham and her husband, Joseph Demusz, of Woburn, Mass., Jay E. Cunningham and his wife, Lori, of Unity. Kelli Couturier and her husband, Glenn, of Montville; seven grandchildren, Nicholas and Emily Demusz of Woburn, Shannon Grant and her husband, Mike, of Brooks, Christi Shaw and her husband, Tim, of New Gloucester, Robert, Bethany and Carrie Couturier of Montville; three great-grandchildren, Michael Alan Grant III and Brennan Jay Grant of Brooks, and Taylor Nicole Shaw of New Gloucester.
