BANGOR – Andre Emerson Cushing Sr., 88, died Monday at a local hospital. He was the grandfather of Vincent Webber of South Portland.

Born in Fort Kent, a son of Andre Richmond and Mary Louise Pomroy Cushing, he attended Hampden and Bangor schools, graduating from Bangor High School in 1924.
