Edward H. Cushman, 77, of 1670 Forest Ave., a retired automobile salesman and former city councilor, died suddenly yesterday at his residence.

He was born in Portland Jan. 4, 1882, the son of Charles M. and Emma Knight Cushman. He attended Deering High School.

Mr. Cushman was associated with the automobile business for 47 years. He worked in Detroit for the Packard Motor Co. before returning to Portland in 1907 to take charge of the service department of Allen Motor Car Co. He also worked for Myron D. Kidder, Inc. From 1933 to 1950 he worked for Northeast Motor Co., retiring as manager of the truck and fleet department.

He was a member of the Society of Automotive Engineers, the second Maine man ever to be selected for membership in that organization.

FORT MEYERS, Fla. — Fred B. Cushman, 89, an osteopathic physician, died in Fort Myers, Fla., on April 23.

He was born in Boston, a son of Ruth B. and Albert N. Cushman, and graduated from Ellsworth (Maine) High School and the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine.

Dr. Cushman was a primary-care physician in Ellsworth and Franklin, Maine, for 48 years. One of the milestones of his practice was the delivery of more than 1,000 babies. Upon his retirement, he received the Jefferson Award for outstanding citizenship to the community.

Dr. Cushman was a lifetime member of the American Osteopathic Association. He belonged also to the Vienna (Austria) Medical Association and the Maine Osteopathic Association.

He had been on the staffs of the James A. Taylor Hospital and the Maine Coast Memorial Hospital in Ellsworth. Dr. Cushman also had been a member of the David A. Hooper Masonic Lodge at North Sullivan, Maine.

Dr. Cushman was predeceased by his wife, Flora Belle, in 1994.

YARMOUTH - Gordon Harold Pete Cushman, 86, died peacefully in his sleep on Monday, April 17, 2006.

He was born in Boston, Mass., on Jan. 14, 1920, the son of Frank H. Cushman and Ida (Buckley) Cushman. He was a member of Kappa Delta Rho while he was at Colgate University and graduated in the Class of 1943.

He served in the US Navy during World War II and commanded LST-316 during the invasion of Normandy Beach.

His management position with Sears brought him and his wife Nancy to Maine. He finished his career as a personnel consultant. He was a member of the Masons - Casco Lodge and the Shriners - Kora Temple. He was Past Patron of the Winnegance Chapter Order of Eastern Star and was on the Advisory Board of Rainbow.
