**CAMDEN** — Dr. Lawrence W. Davee, 93, of 7 Woodcrest Ave. died Thursday at his home after a brief illness.

He was born in Foxcroft, Maine, a son of Everett and Sarah Weston Davee, attended schools in Orono and graduated from Orono High School. He was a 1922 electrical engineering graduate of the University of Maine. He married Muriel Goodrich in 1925 and they moved to Tenafly, N.J., where they lived for many years.

Mr. Davee worked for Bell Labs, Fox Films and was president of the Century Projector Corp. in New York City until he retired. He was responsible for many technological advancements in the motion picture industry, including being part of the team that put the first sound on film.

He was the recipient of the coveted Samuel L. Warner Award for Meritorious Achievement in Sound Motion Picture Engineering, among other awards.

Mr. Davee was an active member of the Masons.

After retirement in 1975, he and his wife moved back to Orono. The couple resided in Camden for the past six years. For nearly 80 years, the Davees had spent summers at Greeley's Landing at Sebec Lake in Dover-Foxcroft.
