Augusta, Sept. 7—Erig. Gen. Charles E. Davis (retired) 79, Assistant Adjutant General of Maine, a veteran of the Spanish-American and World Wars and on duty on the Mexican border during the trouble with the southern Republic in 1916, died suddenly this afternoon at his home, 23 Elm Street.

Worked During Morning

General Davis had attended to his duties at the Adjutant General's office this morning, and appeared to be in good health, but shortly after reaching home he collapsed and died. Funeral arrangements had not been completed tonight, but it was announced that full military honors will be paid.

General Davis, a native of Standish, was for some time a resident of Portland and was a member of the old Portland Cadets, serving in all the enlisted ratings from private to corporal and sergeant. He enlisted in this company Sept. 20, 1880, and remained with the company until its disbandment March 10, 1890.

The Cadet organization became Company B, First Maine Infantry, National Guard, and he was commissioned second lieutenant of the company, May 7, 1891. Seven years later he was recommissioned and subsequently was commissioned captain and served as adjutant of the First Infantry, Jan. 5, 1905 he was appointed a brigadier general, with duties as inspector-general on the Governor's staff, holding this position until Jan. 12, 1909. On Feb. 20 of that year he was retired with the rank of brigadier general, but later teturned to active service and was commissioned major in the Adjutant General's Department. He was again retired June 15, 1916, with the rank of brigadier general and since that time had been Assistant Adjutant General.

His Federal service began with his duties as first lieutenant and adjutant of thee First Infantry, Maine Volunteers, May 2, 1898, and he was made acting Assistant Adjutant General of the Third Brigade, Second Division, Third Corps, June 4. He was mustered out of the Federal service Nov. 16, 1898.

Surviving are a son, Kendall Davis, and a granddaughter, Virginia Davis of Wilmington, Del., and a nephew, Everett Davis of Portland. His wife died in 1933.

Each day the Press Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways. "He told me once that he built in the neighborhood of 100 houses," said his cousin, Reta Herrick of Auburn. "He was a self-made, self-taught man. His basic philosophy as a boss was that you never asked your men to do what you wouldn't do yourself."

His contracting company built the Kingfield Motel, the ski lodge at Titcomb Mountain and many other structures in the area.

Mr. Davis enjoyed talking about history and politics. In 1988, while on

a trip to England, he had a chance meeting with former President Jimmy Carter at Madame Tussaud's Wax Museum in London. "It was crowded," said Herrick. "By and large, the group was English and young, and he (President Carter) hadn't been recognized. Chester was the first in line to shake his hand."

Since the Davises retired to Sea Street in Boothbay Harbor, he enjoyed gardening and building novelty items, such as tiny clam baskets, dinghies and lobster buoys. He and Mrs. Davis kept a display table of handmade novelties and decorative items in their front yard, along with used pieces of furniture, to sell to tourists throughout the summer.

"I think he invented the yard sale," said Mrs. Herrick.

Mr. Davis was born in Brookton Plantation in Washington County, a son of William N. and Amney Stoddard Davis, and attended Danforth schools. During World War I, he attended night school at Morse High School in Bath to learn drafting and other skills.

He attended Farmington Baptist Church and had been a member of the Masons since 1918, first with the Solar Lodge in Bar Harbor and later with the Farmington lodge.

Mrs. Davis died in 1986.

Surviving are a daughter, Louise Packard of Vernon, Conn.; a sister, June Bartlett of Boothbay Harbor; and three grandchildren.
