Howard H. Davis, 41, of 125 Ocean Avenue, died early Friday evening in a local hospital, shortly after drinking poison.

Davis' wife, Mrs.-Marion Davis, told police that her husband gasped to her that he had taken the poison just before he was rushed to the hospital. She tried to get him to drink warm water, she said, the antidote directed on the poison bottle, but he was unable to.

She told police that he had been trying unsuccessfully to sell refrigeration equipment for five weeks.

Dr. Joseph E. Porter, county medical examiner, said he would examine the body this morning to determine the cause of death.

Mrs. Davis said she was out when her husband came home, and when she returned, shortly after 6 p. m. she found him in agony.

Hospital attaches said that the poison is available commercially as an insect spray.

Davis was born Aug. 21, 1908 in Portland, son of the late Clifton L. and Edith Hussey Davis.

He attended South Portland High School and Hebron Academy and was graduated from Burdette College, Boston. He was a member of Hiram Lodge of Masons, South Portland.

Surviving, besides his widow, are his mother and two sons, Clifton, 12, and Theodore, 11.

In recent years he enjoyed hiking and fishing in Baxter State Park "He climbed Mt. Katahdin for the first time when he was 60 years old," said Hall. "He climbed it about three times after that." Born in Edgecomb, a son of Irving L. and Mable C. Decker Davis, he graduated in 1932 from Wiscasset

Academy. He was active for many years in the alumni association of Wiscasset Academy.

During World War II, he served in the Army Air Forces in Europe

An active member of the Masons, he was a past master of the Lincoln Lodge of Masons, past secretary of New Jerusalem of Wiscasset, a past district deputy grand master of Lincoln Royal Arch Chapter of Damariscotta, a past patron of the Garrison Hill Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star, a charter member and first director from Edgecomb of the Lincoln County Cultural and Historical Assoc, and a member of the Bradford-Sortwell-Wright American Legion.
