### Arno N. Day

#### fourth-generation boatbuilder

SEDGWICK - Arno Nevells Day, 81, a lifelong boatbuilder who lectured and taught the art of building wooden boats, died unexpectedly here Thursday.

A fourth-generation boatbuilder, Mr. Day was best known as a designer and builder of wooden lobster boats. He owned his own boatyard and before that he worked at various local yards.

We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting wrys"His life's work, if you will were lobater basts, in the 30- to 35-foo range," said his son James Day, also a basi builder. "They evolved over the years. There: was a series of 35-bot lobater boats he built in the early 1570s that. If you asked him, he'd say they were the ones he was most proud of."

Mr. Day's boat designs have been built around the world, and several of his Maine lobster boats were made in Soattle and used as pleasure

boats. "They're a little different than they're used to out there, so they seemed to catch on," said his son.

Mr. Day learned his trade as a boy, hanging around his grandfather's boat shop. He went into business with his brother and father in Brookin, and they also built military patrol boats in Stonington during World War II.

He tried to get into the service during the war, but was given an exclusion because the government felt he was more valuable building boats. After the war, he found his niche designing and uilding commercial lobster boats.

"He loved wooden boats," said his son. "That's what he loved for."

Mr. Day retired about 16 years ago, but continued to tanch and do design work, the shared his passion for boats design about the shared his passion for boats design about the share has been high School Martine Maseum, Maine Martine Academy and Partern Manee Vocational Technical Institute. Many private projects also came under his tutilage. He was a well known floerner on the evolution of the Maine leabert boat and freely shared his wealth of knowledge in order to perpetate the craft.

"He just gave of himself to the young people who were interested in the same thing," said his sister, Mary E. Hawkins.

In May, the Maine Maritime Academy conferred upon him an honorary doctor of science degree.

 Mr. Day served 25 years on the Brooklin and SAD 73 school boards, and was also a Brooklin selectman. He was a 50-year member of Brooklin Odd Fellows and Center Harbor Rebekah Lodge, and active in the Masons.

Born in Sedgwick, a son of Frank L and Myrtle Nevells Day, he graduated as valedictorian of Brookin High School in 1935. He attended Colby College from 1935-97.

Surviving are his wele of 38 years, Dorothy L. Butler Day, two sons, Stephen E. of Sains Fe, NM. and James A of New Brunskick two disughters, Lois Washburn of Bookeett, NH, and Many Colcord of Barrington, NH, a brother, Frank L. of Brookins, saiter, Mary E. Hawkins of Canden; 10 grandchildren and a great-grandshaghter.

> ginia, Philadelphia, and the Washington, D.C. area.

In 1983 he became the president of Lewiston Raceways, Inc., closing the track in 1990 and developing the area with his son James and daughter Jayne, and re-

turned to Maine as a permanent resident in 1996. Mr. Day has served as President and Chair of the Board for Central Maine Medical Center, and as President of the Beth Jacob Synagogue.

He also served as Presidem of the Florida Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association; as national treasurer of Harness Horse International, the National Association for Owners and Horsemen and Women; and Horsemen and Women; and Horsemen and Womers Hall of Fame in 1987, after owning six world champions and many other great rachne horses.

Private funeral services will be held at 1.30 p. m. Saturday at 9 Everett Avenue



ory said Day, who was criving une car, a light pick-up truck, was hit over the left eye and that death was instantaneous.

After the bullet crashed through the car and hit her husband, Mrs. Day turned off the ignition switch and applied the emergency brake. The vehicle grated against a highway fence for about 150 yards, before coming to a stop, but neither Mrs. Day nor the child was injured.

The family was returning from a holiday celebration at the home of Mrs. Day's father, Mel Greenleaf, Edgecomb.

Lincoln County Sheriff Herbert L. Pinkham said tonight that several hunters known to have been in the vicinity were being questioned. The bullet which claimed Day's life was found on the floor of his car, Pinkham said and the rifles of several of the hunters are being held for ballistics tests.

The hunters, some residents of Maine and others from out of state, "are all being very cooperative with investigating officials," Pinkham added.

Day, who had beeen a resident of Wiscasset since 1934, was graduated from Norway High School and Bay Path Institute, Springfield, Mass. He was a member of the Wiscasset Masonic Lodge and a charter member of the Wiscasset Lions Club organized last week. Surviving, besides his widow and son, is his father, Wesley C. Day, manager of the Wiscasset branch
